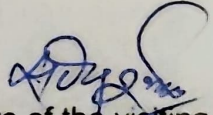


L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
Res	1. Non fulfilment of demands raised in the B2V1 2. Non availability kerosene oil depot & LPG outlet 3. Bad condition of electric supply line/erection of iron electric poles 4. Non-availability of Doctor at Mulwana jagir 5. Non-availability of Hr. Sec. School at Mulwana jagir 6. Insufficient teaching staff in schools/Repairment of damaged schools

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	The public in general did not see any sign of improvement with regard to fulfillment of basic needs. However they are optimistic of good governance in future.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	The public in general needs delivery at doorsteps. Merely organising Back to Village Programme is not sufficient. It should be result oriented. The poor people in Mulwana Jagir still needs a Doctor, teacher, good school, Kerosene oil, LPG outlet etc. No one District level officer has ever visited Mulwana Jagir. So my suggestion to the Govt is to depute every concerned District level officer to Mulwana East Panchayat to listen to their voice.

1) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

1. Unhygienic drinking water facility / Available supply not sufficient.
2. Non-availability of Road Connectivity to different hamlets like Banashalla, Maslail, Punnakar, Chabbar, Lohapura, Battal, Kunnaralek;
3. Fixation of Electric wires on wooden poles and use of Barked wire in some areas.
4. Non-availability of Higher Secondary School in the area. Students have to travel to Gundana for studies.
5. Improper drainage system in villages of the Panchayat.
6. Damaged Irrigation kulels/canals, because of PMGSY Roads construction.
7. Non-availability of K oil Depot, LPG outlet and Firewood Depot.
8. Non-payment of compensation to landowners / House owners.
9. Non-availability of a Sewing Center in the area.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

1. Upgradation of Govt. High School Malwana to Higher Sec. level.
2. Repairment of damaged School buildings especially at HS Malwana.
3. Road Connectivity to all hamlets of Panchayat especially Banashalla.
4. Opening of K oil Depot, LPG Outlet and Firewood Depot.
5. Bad Condition of Power supply lines / Replacement of wooden poles.
6. Non-availability of a Doctor at Malwana.
7. Repairment of damaged kulels/canals.
8. Opening of Food supply store & winter storage.
9. Appointment of Chowkidar at Malwana Jagir.
10. Opening of Veterinary Centre and posting of a doctor.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions)

The Panchayat is hilly in terrain and the hamlets are scattered. All the hamlets especially Banashalla needs to be provided with road connectivity which shall ease out the sufferings of people. The damaged canals need to be repaired which shall provide irrigation facility to various areas and help in increasing the farmers income. The education system needs to be improved by way of upgradation of High School to Higher Secondary School. The wooden poles carrying electric wires need to be replaced starting from the most vulnerable ones. Health Sector requires the posting of a doctor in the area. Opening of Sewing centres shall be helpful in participation of women folk for upliftment of Rural economy. The drinking water supply system needs to be improved by way of constr. of reservoir tanks and repairment of running lines. The drainage system in these villages needs to be developed.
