

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Main economic activities/ source of livelihood in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Agriculture
2. Horticulture
3. Unskilled labours (major portion)
4. Landless labours.
5. Skilled labours.

Major potential areas which can be used to improve economic conditions in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Agriculture by providing new modes of irrigation.
2. Horticulture by restarting juice plant of JKHPMC.
3. By introducing skill development courses like repairing of electrical appliances.
4. Fisheries & introducing new schemes via Animal, sheep husbandary.
5. Handicrafts.

Major problems confronting the people in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Lack of proper Irrigation system.
2. Drainage of rain and waste water in inner links.
3. Traffic jam due to Point Mandi and hence lack of Bypass road.
4. Lack of proper drinking water facility.
5. Outdated electricity network (HT + LT).

IV	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07)
1.	Lift-Irrigation Scheme near Saifkhal at river Shelum for irrigation (Approx. 1km).
2.	By-pass road from Sheikh-mohalla to river Shelum.
3.	Protection wall on Pohnu-nalla from filtration plant to Pandith bagh.
4.	Drainage and murgdamization of inner links.
5.	Upgradation of filtration plant to rapid sand and replacement of pipe network distribution system.
6.	Upgradation of BMS Mazbogh to High School.
7.	Construction of Community Hall/marriage Hall.
V	Any major complaint brought to notice:
	The people mostly complained against PHE department. During the sight visit I too realized the negligence of said department. It is therefore requested that necessary action may kindly be taken against the department.
