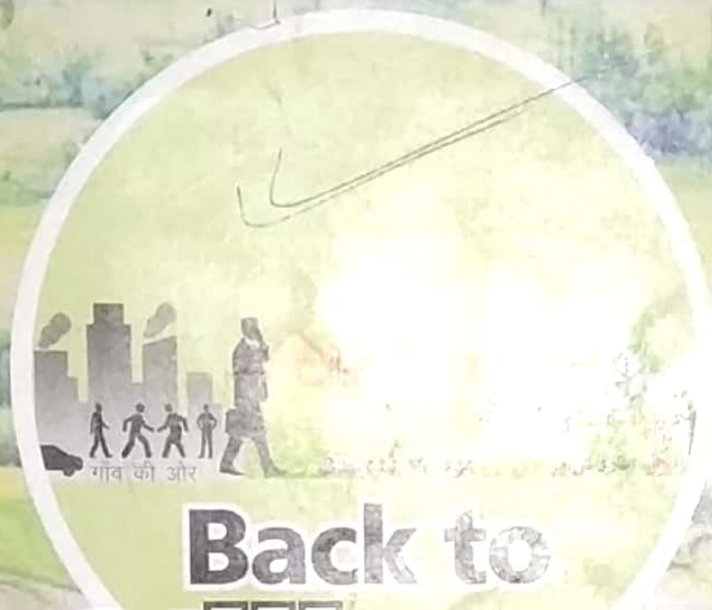

	Panchayats are functioning smoothly but Panch Sarpanchs complained that some of the Govt. Deptts are not honouring them and are taking decisions unilaterally and they may be made aware about their responsibilities towards them.
