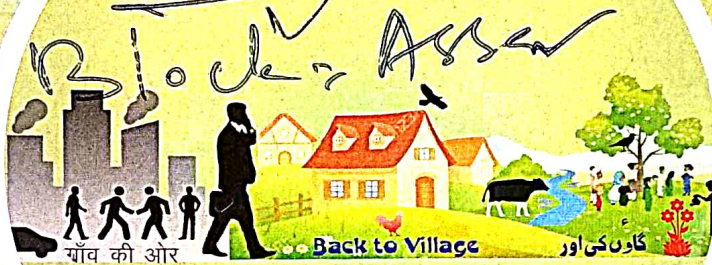

E) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Main economic activities/ source of livelihood in the GP (Max. 05):

- I
1. Cattle rearing
2. Agriculture/farming
3. Horticulture
4. Labour
5. Sheep and goat rearing

Major potential areas which can be used to improve economic conditions in the GP (Max. 05):

- II
1. Tourism like pleasure/religious/adventure can be promoted as the area is hilly and covered with dense forest.
2. Fruit production can be improved by assistance from horticulture dept.
3. Agriculture centres need to be opened to increase productivity of farmers.
4. Sheep husbandry dept should intervene to increase productivity/breed.
5. As cattle rearing is main activity, animal husbandry dept should provide technical assistance.

Major problems confronting the people in the GP (Max. 05):

- III
1. No road connectivity in the panchayat.
2. Providing drinking water supply to the unconnected hamlets.
3. Providing electricity to unconnected hamlets.
4. Providing required teaching faculty in most of the schools.
5. Need technical/financial assistance from Agriculture, horticulture, sheep/animal husbandry depts to improve economic conditions of the people.

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IV	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	Wrong categorization in ration cards and pending MGNREGA issues of payments.
2.	Staff shortage in schools and vegetable market at Thanda pane.
3.	JK Bank branch and police post at Thanda pane.
4.	Animal, sheep husbandry, agriculture and veterinary centres in the panchayat. (2)
5.	Providing road connectivity, water connectivity and electricity connectivity. (1)
6.	VAC issues and providing transformers (3) for better light.
7.	Establishing patwar khana and afforestation of barren/vacant state land.
V	Any major complaint brought to notice:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No road connectivity in the panchayat. - Some hamlets are without electricity. - Water connectivity in some hamlets. - Staff shortage in most of the schools.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Water harvesting ponds constructed by RAA. - Toilets constructed in all schools and also in hamlets. - Drains and pucca paths in hamlets by RAA deptt.
