2.	Selling of fruits and vegetables adds to the income of villagers.
3.	Some percentage of people of GP are Govt. employees as their source of livelihood.
4.	Job-cards given to some jobless persons also proves source of income for some people.

II	Major potential areas which can be used to improve economic conditions in the GP (Max. 05):
1.	Since Agriculture is the main potential area of GP. So improve its irrigation supply to its best possible, so that better results of crop improvement can be achieved.

4.	Some areas of GP are gifted by Mineral Gypsum. Efforts be made to explore the possibility of such minerals on large scale.

III	Major problems confronting the people in the GP (Max. 05):
1.	Connectivity from Kora Pani to most of the hamlets of GP by road is very concerning. Either no link roads or totally worse conditioned roads.

4.	KGBV school in Jathi faces a major issue of accommodation and playground facility
5.	Poor supply of drinking water to GP (Kuthyala) is a major issue confronting people.

1. Black Topping of Link Road from Kora Pani To Kudgawn.
2. Need primary health centre in Kudgawn and Sub centre in other wards of GP.
3. Establish and manage road connectivity to all wards of GP Kuthyala.
4. Prepare at least 1-2 playgrounds in GP Kuthyala.
5. Make Available skill development centres in GP.
6. Require drinking water supply to Dhangal area and from Kora Pani To Kudgawn. Via Nilhote.
7. Need of street lights and guest house in Kudgawn village.

V Any major complaint brought to notice:

- i) Poor response and work performance of Patwar Bansi Lal towards villagers of GP Kuthyala.
- ii) village shulote has been totally neglected in terms of Link road, drinking water and other facilities.
