Under Panchayati Raj Act, departments under the umbrella of pyt. are not adhering the provisions of Act, except few likes RDD and PR, Agriculture, ICDS, Education sector and Asha workers of Health Department. Public not satisfied with these deptt. even calling by the Sarpanch, not attending the programme

Overall assessment of visit (Panchayat Functioning)

Development of natural resources like land, water, human resources, these resources can be developed for the upliftment of living standard of general public of pyt. and also to generate the income of pyt. by exploiting these resources scientific and technological manner by this practice, we manage to curtail the migration of rural population towards the urban areas.
