i) Names deleted/missing/not found in SECC 2011 data. Hence, various government benefits not being availed. ii) Pensions pending for the last 2-3 years like widow, old age, disability, etc iii) PDD - Destruction of infrastructure during heavy rains/snowfall due to a) use of wooden poles b) less span between wires(short circuit during heavy winds) c) Instead of cement base of poles, private contractors use sand bags to erect poles and thus reduce cost. During snowfall, poles fall and power line gets disrupted for days and sometimes weeks. iv) Anganwadi workers - a) Ration available once a year no adequate storage mechanisms and hence gets rotten. b) Carriage charges borne by anganwadi workers themselves. c) Shift ration depot to Basantgarh from Majouri for convenience and reduced costs.
