GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Main economic activities/ source of livelihood in the GP (Max. 05):

Major potential areas which can be used to improve economic conditions in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Cold Storage for Agricultural and horticultural purposes can improve economic conditions
2. Urgent need of agricultural sub-division and separate horticulture dept.
3. Govt. Handicraft Centre for empowering women.
4. MGNREGA (wages if increased and paid on time)

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Major problems confronting the people in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Improper and poorly constructed drains lead to accumulation of stagnant water causing threat to locals.
 2. As LT and HT lines are lying/running very low and over rotten wooden poles & trees it poses threat to locals
 3. There is a serious problem regarding entertainment, land is available for converting it into public park. (flouriculture park)
 4. A number of old and rotten trees are around the building of panchayat/CFC, posing threat to property of panchayat, urgent need to cut them
- Local streams pose threat during rainy/spring season, so widening, deeping and new culverts

IV Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):

1. Cold storage urgently needed as land is already available under JKHPMC.

2. As Govt. land has been illegally occupied by locals, urgent need is to free govt. land from occupiers.

3. Urgent filling and leveling and seating of mini-stadium is needed.

4. Urgent need of J&K Bank branch with ATM.

5. Electric receiving station is urgently needed besides water reservoir tank is needed.

6. Drainage is badly affected. Construction and then maintenance of drains is needed.

7. Fencing around Govt middle school, PHE tank, Panchayat / CFC building is urgently needed.

V Any major complaint brought to notice:

There is a serious problem of drug (illegal) addiction in local youth. Measures must be taken to curb this menace. Use of charas, Brown sugar and other illicit drugs is on high in the local youth. Needs strict action.

VI Overall assessment of visit (Public Services): Please mention best practices, if any, observed

The visit was very effective. On observation it was found that the drainage and care of govt. buildings has been neglected. Proper sanitation, construction of public parks, drains, fencing of LMS school, Panchayat gas is urgently required.

The Sarpanch and local MPW were very supportive, enthusiastic & eager to work for LP. They should be duly supported. The duty of LRS was satisfactory.
