

ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

1. Major economic activities/ source of livelihood in the GP (Max. 05):

The major portion of population in GP comprises of labour class and depends on availability of work in public and pvt. sector.

There are nominal economic activities in agriculture sector and surplus yield/produce if any is sold within GP in an unorganised system.

Most of the population is directly or indirectly connected with horticulture and its allied activities to earn their livelihood.

A few households are earning their livelihood from apiculture and sericulture and small scale business.

A decimal number of people are employees under public and pvt. sector.

2. Major potential areas which can be used to improve economic conditions in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Installation of fruit processing units in terms of juice extraction, jam packaging can generate employment.

2. Establishment of skill development training centres like carpentry, electric works, soldering and welding etc. Needle work, carpet weaving etc. along with provision of stipends in favour of trainees will attract unemployed youth.

3. Special attention in apiculture, sericulture, floriculture as there are vast avenues for their promotion and financial assistance be provided to boost these sectors.

4. Waiving of agricultural loans and provision of interest free and time bound loans to the self help groups connected with agriculture and its allied activities.

5. Special Recruitment Drive for unemployed youth who couldn't complete their studies due to poverty and also enhancement of financial assistance given to weaker section of the society.

3. Major problems confronting the people in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Scarcity of drinking water as there is no proper mechanism of water harvesting and tapping system.

2. Lack of proper Health and medicare facility.

3. Dilapidated Condition of main roads, link roads and lack of drainage system.

4. Discontinuous and a periodic electric supply particularly in winters is a big problem faced by the locals.

5. Lack of proper irrigation facilities and lack of Cold Storage for preservation of horticulture yield is long standing issue.

IV Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):

1. Sanctioning of PHC to Cater Health and medicare side of no. Grampanchayat Aloosa tehsik also.
2. Provision of Fire and emergency Services to Tehsik and deployment of Fire engine and makeshift.
3. macadamisation and upgradation of roads, link roads and Cons. of a new 0.1 km road from GP Aloosa to Ashtangou village Through R. Mohalla to boost Transport of horticulture produce and as shortest Comm. between both the village.
4. Construction of bridge over nagmarg nallah near Rangwar to facilitate Communication.
5. Construction of water harvesting tanks at Ghorwian and adjacent hamlets for irrigation purpose and also Construction of lift irrigation Proj.

V Any major complaint brought to notice:

The dwellers of GP complained of indifference / negligence shown to the Govt towards the GP and dereliction in monitoring of developmental works and also lack of basic facilities. The GP needs immediate attention and sympathetic consideration from Govt.

VI Overall assessment of visit (panchayat functioning)

Recently Constituted panchayat is functional though in sluggish pace the Sarpanch of the Panchayat Halqa is energetic devoted and dedicated person. However the reconstruction of fire galled panchayat building, fencing of panchayat land and Construction of a Community Hall is the immediate need for its smooth functioning. Tendering process of Dev. works in PG be also made transparent.

VII Overall assessment of visit (public Services) please mention best practices if any observe

The programme (Back to village) launched by the Govt would prove very fruitful to get information from zero ground about the future requirements and also execution and implementation of Dev. works taken up by the Govt from the zero ground. As a visiting officer I would like to place on record that the response of the common people was overwhelming and a reason to sensitize the Govt functionaries whose response was apt mark. Follow up the programme is a need of present scenario.
