Panchayat Ebar is not yet constructed. The Administration needs to construct it on priority so that all panchayat related activities are started and villagers gather at a single meeting point. Also, above 7' points under urgent public requirement needs to be given top priority & address them same on fast-track basis.

The visit was overall fruitful. People/villagers came forward to express their issues/problems confronting them related to development activities and administration need to give top priority to this Halga as far as solutions to the problems faced by them are concerned.

As the new Panchayat has come into existence recently & only Sarpanch has got appointed without panchs, so such functioning is not upto the expectations of the villagers. The effort need to be something in this regard so that it is notified and villagers should get feel that Panchayat is doing something for them. But some development activities have been taken up by the Panchayat with a encouraging need to do more.
