Major potential areas which can be used to improve economic conditions in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Dairy farming, bee keeping, Mushroom cultivation, Sericulture.

2. Establishment of Skill dev. centre for vocational training.

3. Development of SHAL-DOON (Local Hilllock) as tourism spot.

4. Since the area has a thick population of millmen, it is suggested to establish a dairy plant in GP to provide jobs to locals.

5. Micro credit be made available to the small & marginal farmers, artisans to augment their financial position.

Major problems confronting the people in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Lack of proper transport facility, faulty water supply and dilapidated condition of roads. Lack of primary health centre and Middle School.

2. Playground facility not available anywhere in GP.

3. Electric wires HT/LT running over residential houses at many spots - Needs to be routed through alternate & less hazardous routes.

4. Procedure of granting financial assistance from Social welfare & labour deptt be made easier for timely distribution.

5. Severe shortage of drinking water.

IV	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	construction of protection bunds at different spots Hapat Nar Nallah upto Dule A to Samigee canal
2.	Urgent need of middle school / primary health with ambulance.
3.	Macadamisation and C/O drain alongside of road from Jamia Qadeem to Sopore - Bpr road via Kenkri met. Removal of encroachment on said road at Kenkri.
4.	Restoration of Delgam & Kethi khul for irrigation purposes. Removal of encroachment on both khuls.
5.	Installation of Solar Street Lights.
6.	Installation of pump-shed near paver project for irrigation.
7.	Opening of more Agamwadi centres in GP.
V	Any major complaint brought to notice:
	Shifting of HT lines over Jamia Masjid and some residential houses of Shree Gojri Mohalla - Replacement of rusted GI pipes. Improvement of overall drainage system in GP. Removal of encroachment at different spots to establish Govt offices on Govt. land.
