I	Main economic activities/ source of livelihood in the GP (Max. 05):
1.	Majority of people are working in unorganised sectors like casual labourers, part-time shopkeepers, helpers.
2.	Some few hamlets are famous for producing good quality cheese, which is famous in entire district
3.	Cattle Rearing, Poultry can also be seen in few hamlets.
4.	Welding shops, Carpentry & Blacksmiths are present in G.P.

II	Major potential areas which can be used to improve economic conditions in the GP (Max. 05):
1.	Local Quality of cheese is famous in district, therefore needs organised market place.
2.	Walnut and Apple are major fruits grow while Quince is produced at large quantity, therefore relevant market place needs to be established.
3.	Majority of young generation are school dropouts, therefore skill development unit will be helpful of generate employment.
4.	The Stone Quarry at Palayan possess good quality stone which is placed in state land, accessibility to this place can enhance the economic activity in G.P.
5.	Lift Irrigation System should be installed in Satarwaji to enhance the crop productivity and yield.

III	Major problems confronting the people in the GP (Max. 05):
1.	Road Connectivity is not available in Dajjie, Bagwana, Chamlie, Bhadran & Satarwaji.
2.	Water crises in Dajjie, Bagwana & Bhadran hamlets.
3.	Education :- Many teachers are attached to other offices at district level, hence students are suffering
4.	MRDD :- Delay in payment of Material and skilled labour.
5.	PDD :- Power curtailment because of extra load on 6MW Grid Station at Dadepet.

4.	Banking facility at Bhata, Suzna and Bhadran Palmar. (ATM services).
5.	Construction of Building of higher Secondary School at Bhata Palmar.
6.	Construction of Panchayat Ghar in G.P.
7.	Drainage System in Chamlie, Suzna, Bhata, Dajjie, Bhadran and Satawaji.

	- Major resentment is shown towards the working of RDO regarding payment of materials, skilled labour and delay in payment made there of. - The Principal/Teachers of the HSS and MS are not regularly performing their duties, and but are enjoying at the head offices in cities.

	Best practice :- The interaction at night with the local residents. The people at village are very kind and humble, But they are lacking the basic amenities which I came to know after this visit. Overall, It was an amaze awesome experience.

	PRIs still do not function, as it has to be. The awareness and accountability of PRIs is lacking. Therefore regular training of Panches, Sarpanches needs to be done.
