Additional demands as raised by the Members of PRI and Prominent citizens of Panchayat Halqa 'FEDARPORA'

- (1) upgradation of Road from Jamia Masjid fedarpara upto Nallah Hamal.
- (2) construction of community Hall with IT facilities.
- (3) Sanction of PDS outlet (Food Store).
- (4) Sanction of Fire & Emergency Services.
- (5) Sanction of veterinary / Sheep Extension centre.
- (6) Availability of fertiliser / pesticides outlet.
- (7) construction of Anganwadi centres at fedarpara and Manchampora with toilet facility.
- (8) upgradation of ~~Post~~ Police Post to Police station.
- (9) Providing of Protection bund at different spots on Nallah Hamal.
- (10) Construction of surface drains at different spots at fedarpara & Manchampora.
- (11) Providing of Hand pump & Tub wells. (15 Nos)
