

4) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):

1. Maintenance / Buiding of main road. The sliding portion of the main road should be reconstructed and the concerned department be made accountable.
 2. Water Supply Scheme to avaraman has many shortfalls. People are dissatisfied with the scarcity of drinking water. Additional arrangements be taken up.
 3. Health Centre is in a dilapidated condition. It looks like a cowshed. Health facilities are not upto mark. Requirement of building and additional staff.
 4. The area falls in "Red Zone" as per the report of ecology and mining department. It is the need of the hour to identify safe area for the inhabitants of Waranman.
 5. School compound of GHS Waranman Bin need of fencing of the compound and provision of ICT lab be made for the High School having Co-Education.
 6. Services of PDD department need to be improved. The public often complains about frequent power cuts due to insufficient power supply. 10MVA transformer be installed at Grid Station Chandrasa.
 7. Panchayat Ghar is still not available at the Pandya Nagar. The New Panchayat Ghar be constructed at an earlier date.
 8. Public Library for youth be established on priority basis.
- Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

- 1) Drainage system is totally defunct in the Panchayat. Awareness camps for introduction of various schemes be organised in the village so that common masses could be able to make benefits. HT line passing over Asthan Mohalla should be shifted as there scarcity of construction land and the said HT line should be established away from the houses of the Asthan Mohalla so that people could be able to construct houses in that area. The response of R & B department was not upto mark during the Back to village programme. None of the field officers than helper was present.
