1. The Main Road and Main irrigation pipeline are misaligned and are causing damages and hampering expansion of road.

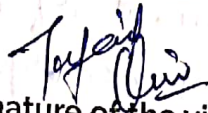
2. Old, worn out drinking water supply pipeline network. Also blockages in irrigation Canals and poorly designed railway tunnel.

IV	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	Main Road and Main irrigation pipeline need to be re-aligned to ensure expansion of roads and expansion/regular maintenance of roads and irrigation system.
2.	Old/worn out drinking water supply infrastructure needs to be replaced/upgraded.
3.	Computerized settlement of land is urgently needed to avoid any illegal encroachment of land such as in Pankispora area.
4.	A new type primary/secondary health center and pharmacy are required with regular ambulance service.
5.	Education sector needs to be upgraded alongside infrastructure development of schools/educational institutions.
6.	The area is direly in need of a playground for sports and recreational activities.
7.	Electric LT/HT networks need to be renovated and old old worn out network to be replaced. The area is unmotored. Same needs to be addressed.
V	Any major complaint brought to notice:
	A major complaint brought to notice is the illegal encroachment of Pasture land in Pankispora locality. The encroachment is majorly due to non-settlement of land.

	It was a great experience working alongside a very dedicated team of officials and a well disciplined and co-operative public. All govt. facilities, institutions and installations were visited and the same was followed by a cleanliness drive.
