

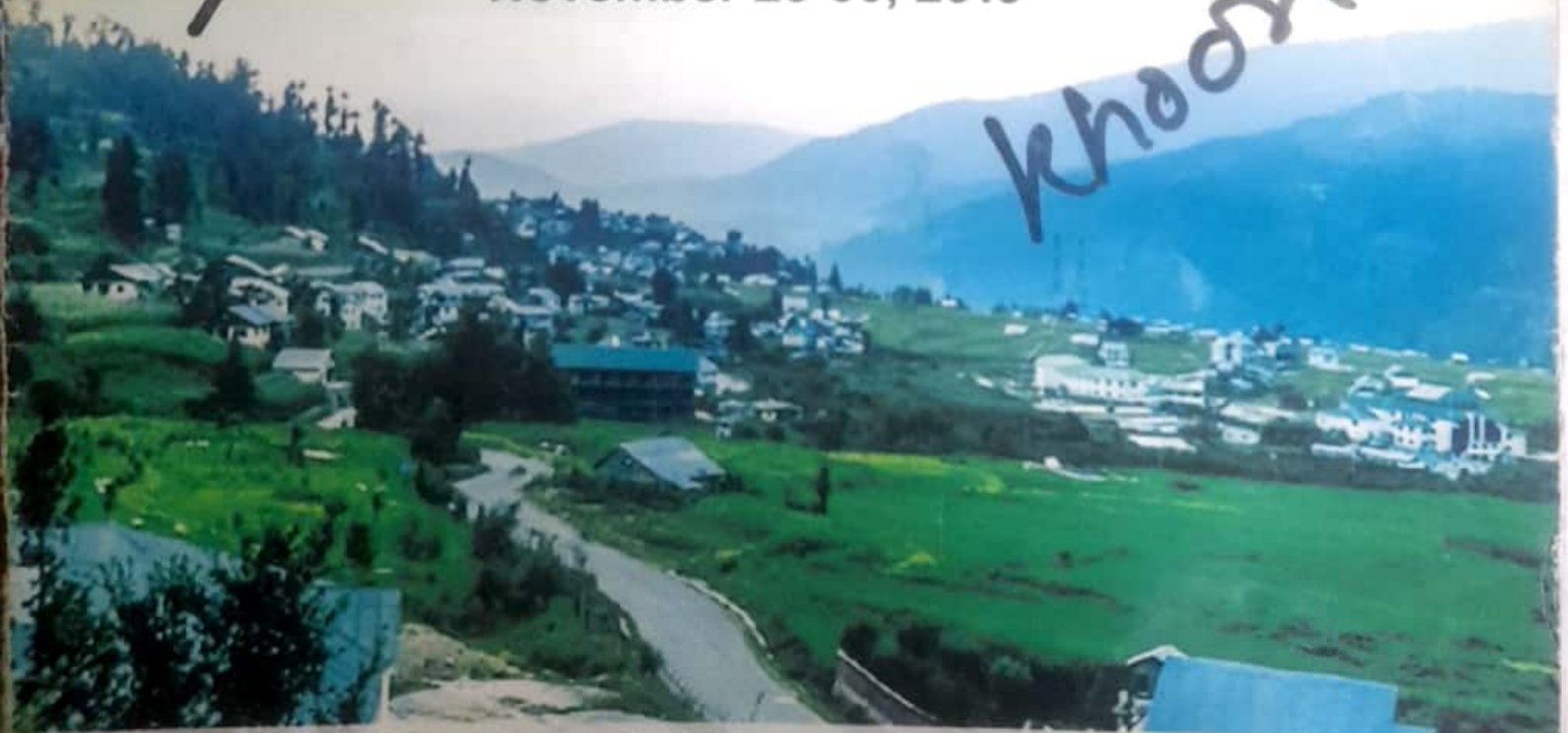

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III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

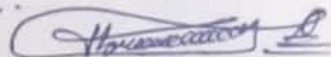
