Performance of Rural development department , agriculture, horticulture and fisheries seems to be good whereas MGNREGA supporting staff seems to be doing well for the enhancement of wages of MGNREGA and AWC's of ICDS department.

General Assessment Of The Visiting Officer

Horticulture crops like - Walnut,Plum,Apricot,Anardana etc.

Sheep and goat rearing, poultry farming.

Fisheries production- Common Carp etc.

Major potential areas which can be used to improve economic conditions in the GP

To develop tourism sector as the climate is very conducive and having large scale potential. Along with side, chapari water fall of 400 ft height, chamal Mata Temple and Sawalakote project over river chenab are not far away and not explored.

In order to improve the economic condition of the inhabitants, cultivation of cash crops like ginger, garlic, turmeric, as well as sowing of high yielding variety of major crops recommended.

In horticulture sector, improved/hybrid cultivars of walnut, plum, apple, apricot is required. Also need to introduce Almond and cherry as the climate is very conducive.

In dairy farming, there is need to introduce high yielding breeds of milking animals, as there could be large scale production of Kalaris and other milk products.

In tourism point of view road link, cooperative society/marketing society is the need of the hour to sell their agriculture and horticulture products by branding as local and organic and can improve their economic condition.

Major problems confronting the people in the GP

Farmers have not sown paddy crop during the current season, i.e; of three villages because of damage of irrigation khul (canal) at different places at Nalli Nikka.

Requirement of staff at sub center PHC, ICDS center, schools. Also requirement to open some centers, stores of different departments.

Major problem which the inhabitants are facing of bus service, which is very poor, only 2 buses ply.

Enrollment under PM kisan, but no payment has been made to the 130 no. of beneficiaries under the said scheme.

Bathroom payments has not been made to the beneficiaries under APL category, about 30 cases are still pending.

1) Filtration plant/ Reservoirs already existing remained non functional. 2) Old age pension forms filled but not issued from 2 years. 3) No case under PM kisan , has been issued after filing 130 cases. 4) Repayment issue of SHG's in 10 months , extended to 20 months , interest should be decreased. 5) Girdawaries related to 9 educational and 1 panchayat has not been made by rev. deptt. 6) Enhancement in the wages of GRS and AWC's.
