2. Better quality roads.

4. Small runniment hospital with modern diagnostic facilities (USG, X-ray) & a veterinarian.

7. A 24-hour health facility.

V. Any major complaint brought to notice:

Electric transmission system is outdated & dilapidated with lines hanging at many places; makeshift poles have been erected posing a threat to life and property.

VI. Overall assessment of visit (Public Services): Please mention best practices, if any, observed

Apparently all departments (with exception) are doing a good job but seem to lack an awareness/outreach necessary for the general public to get benefitted.

VII. Overall assessment of visit (Panchayat Functioning)

The Panchayat seems to be doing a good job viz. preparation of plan & conducting routine meetings. All employees seems to be aware about their role & responsibility. Staff if regularized would go a long way in alleviating problems of people at the grass root level.
