I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
	There is a dire need of drinking water facility as the already existing pipelines are blocked creating a lot of inconvenience to the inhabitants. The inhabitants also brought in my notice the non-availability of the transport system. They also demand the establishment of NHTPC, agricultural sub-centre and animal husbandry sub-centre. They also demanded for the proper furnishing of the telecommunication & internet facility. They also demand for the irrigation facilities & bore wells.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
	1. Dire need of drinking water facility. 2. Better transport system 3. Upgradation of existing middle school to secondary level. 4. Establishment of agricultural sub-centre. 5. Establishment of animal husbandry sub-centre 6. Establishment of TDK Bank along with ATM facility. 7. Non availability of the internet facility. 8. Availability of the play field. 9. Bunding in old wards especially at ward 2nd.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is accompanied by concrete suggestions.)
	During thorough visit, it came to my notice that there is a dire need of drinking water facility to the inhabitants. There is also the lack of irrigation facilities, agricultural sub-centre, animal husbandry sub-centre as the entire GP population is engaged in agricultural work. To promote their agricultural work, they need better transport system, internet facility, banking facility as well as electricity without load shedding. Construction of bunds, drains and culverts in various wards of G.P.
