a)	Road from National Highway to Mallian Mohallah is in dilapidated condition which hinders the smooth mobility.
b)	There is no Primary Health Centre in S. Panchayat People have no First aid Facility in Emergency condition.
c)	The Health sub centres need to be aligned with Udhampur Block instead of Tikeri Block which is very far away from S.P. & it takes lot of time to shift patients.
d)	Sliding of Area in W.No.2 (Mohallah Bain) needs immediate Restoration work.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
1.	Primary Health Centre is main Demand of S.P Dorsoo but same has not been addressed so far.
2.	CRC Building in S.P Dorsoo is also a pending demand
3.	Water lifting from Dhudhary Nallah to village Sudhary was also demanded.
4.	Sub Centre Animal Husbandry was also demanded that is still pending
5.	Tailoring & Cutting and Computer Centres were also demanded.

	The Panchayat Dorsoo is a Remote Panchayat where it was observed that a lot needs to be done in Panchayat. It doesn't have Electricity connection as on date. Moreover the terrain is hilly the Road condition is very bad & water and Electricity are also major issues which needs redressal as top priority. Moreover there is no STS, no skilled development institute and same results in non exposure of local youth to skill activities. It was also observed that some Deptt. have no presence and people have to travel alot which results in wastage of time and non-participation in development activities, Deptt. need to be more participative in all the programmes along with S. Panchayat Members so that the benefit of the schemes is provided to poor & the poorest & various new initiatives need to be taken up to improve Economy of the Area.
