III. Major problems confronting the people in the GP (Max. 05):

1. Lack of quality health care facilities, dearth of qualified medical & other medical staff, Non-access to source/primary health care facilities, & lack of ambulance service.

2. Lack of vocational training institutes, both undergraduate & post graduate level of SKILL training. Are un-employed always.

3. Entrepreneurship of State level, Karnataka, water bodies & health Deptt supply to the G.P. water, power, fuel, etc. With no provision for concessional benefits to consumers buying below primary level.

4. Education facilities, old & shabby high schools, rooms used to educate students from remote areas.

IV Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):

1. Conservation & Preservation of fresh water body (Canal) by framing a restoration plan after seeking proper technical advice. Rampant pollution, dumping of sewage waste & encroachments has rendered it unfit for use.

2. Protection work of the irrigation Canal which acts as a source of irrigation water facility to the Paddy fields of the G.P.

5. Setting up of Primary Health Care Centre in the P.H. with adequate trained staff.

6. Laying of fresh water supply pipes as the existing pipes have been laid long back & are over time with perforation leading to water leakage & contamination.

V Any major complaint brought to notice (7) Setting of proper drainage network & sewage treatment plant

1. Encroachment in the P.H. to be removed immediately esp. ground water Canal & State / Kacharail Canal.

2. Removal of Household waste, garbage needs immediate attention.
