I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer;

① Electric wire supported by trees runs like a dancing death throughout the village, a danger for life and property. ② Lack of drainage. ③ Dilapidated inner links. ④ A number of works/projects are either languishing or left incomplete for unknown reasons like middle school check Pala. ⑤ Increase in water capacity of reservoir or new water reservoir is the most stressed demand of the public as the already constructed reservoir has less capacity which is not fulfilling the needs of the public, needs upgradation at the earliest.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

1. Upgradation of water reservoir.
2. Wooden poles to be replaced by metallic poles and creation of transformers at new colony check payeen, Sidiqui colony, check payeen, Mughalpora and Mir-pora.
3. Upgradation of roads, inner links and improvement of drainage.
4. A number of works/projects are either languishing or left incomplete for unknown reasons like middle school building at check Pala Saloosa and project of Khalji Koul. ⑤ Upgradation of ISM dispensary to PHC.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

⑥ Establishment of Bank and ATM. ⑦ Demand of youth for library cum reading room.

During the visit some genuine concerns raised by the people need immediate action which include upgradation of water reservoir at check Pala Saloosa, faulty drainage, dilapidated inner links and undersized dilapidated wooden poles throughout the village. Strong and enduring embankments on Khalji Koul and the most stressed public demand for the creation of transformers at New colony check payeen, Sidiqui colony check payeen, Mughalpora and Mir-pora and burning desire of youth for a library cum reading room in Panchayat Halqa Saloosa.
