Most respectfully I Mohd Waseem student of LLM at Aligarh Muslim university on behalf of the resident of village lower Banola and upper Banola bring it into your kind notice that for the past several years village lower Banola and upper Banola of tehsil Mendhar of district Poonch of Jammu and Kashmir was not shown under actual line of control.

Whereas it is prima facie established that these village i.e. lower Banola and upper Banola actually falls within actual line if control.

However, the reason for not declaring both villages under ALC has been unknown since 1981/82. There might have been mistake of appropriate authorities or the ignorance of resident of these villages that the present issue have never raised.

In this regard relevant points are discussed briefly as below.

- That two villages i.e. lower Banola and upper Banola actually adjoins actual line of control geographically.
- That it is pertinent to mention here that a village namely BHATIDHAR of Mendhar tehsil is located adjacent to village Banola and the said village i.e. Bhatidhar is under ALC category.
- That another village i.e. NAROL of Tehsil Mendhar is located to 2 to 3 kilometer in back ward direction is under ALC category. Whereas village lower Banola and upper Banola is kept outside the ALC category.
- Therefore it is matter of common knowledge that the areas which comes first in ALC range should be under ALC category.
- That it is also pertinent to mention here that village lower Banola and upper Banola are kept outside ALC category since 1981/82 and the reason for not keeping these villages under ALC category may be due to the mistake of authorities.
- That both lower Banola and upper Banola is educationally and economically backward villages since independence therefore RBA status should also be given to these villages.
- 7. Therefore due to non-inclusive of lower Banola and upper Banola into ALC category and RBA category caused grave injustice to the resident of both villages. And if it would be continue that will cause further injustice and it will be great obstacle in the development of these villages.
