	A culvert 1.5m RCC slab is partially damaged near house of Sh. Bal Singh at village Karnale chole. JE concerned is directed to prepare the estimate and start the work at the earliest. Newly constructed Tube well at village Karnale chole is giving supply only to half of the village. Whole village should be given supply of water from this tube well. Compensation for the crops damaged in year 2019 was not given. Big dumpers carrying sand and bajri from near by crushers during damages to internal links and houses of village Karnale chole. To avoid such movements it is demand of people of the village that joining end point of PMGSY road from Suresh chole to Chak Lohi Shah with the main Road coming from 4th stage near the shop of Raghuvir Singh of Karnale chole. (Length - 500mtr).
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far.
	1. Urgent demand of Panchayat Ghar. 2. Bund/Embankment on right side of river Tawi from 4th stage to 5th stage at village Suresh chole. Length = 1000mtr. 3.
