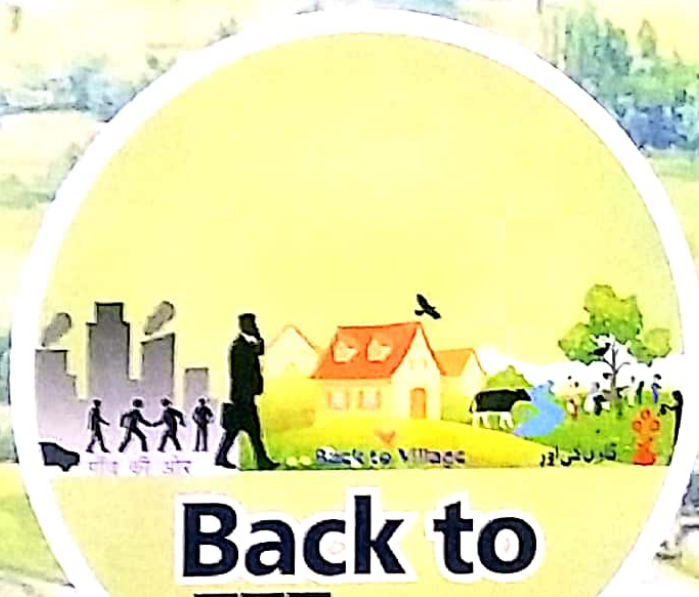

	2. Higher Education for Students need Higher Sec. School (10+2) at Chali Garh as it is 17km away.
	3. No NET connectivity need mobile towers in Panchayat area.
	4. For Block related works have to go to Hoshiarpur.
	5. Block Office be shifted to Chali Garh being Centre of 4 Panchayats.
	6. Upgradation of Health Sub Centre to PHC for better health care facilities.

The Public was made aware about it also to get assistance through KCC, DESS & other schemes.

6 Rectification of Revenue Records as people having cultivation & Kabasa of land since 70-80 years. But land ownership is on names of Office people due to which land compensation & PM Kisan Card is not given.

IV	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	Improvement in water supply system in Panchayat.
2.	Higher Sec. School in Panchayat at present they have to go 17 km for it.
3.	Shifting of B. D. O. office to Chali Gach as four Panchayats have given resolution for being under.
4.	Installation of Mobile Tower for NET connectivity as at present no net connectivity available.
5.	Upgradation of Health Subcentre to PHC as at present they have to go 17 km to light house.
6.	Repair of irrigation canals & transfer of same to irrigation Dept. for upgradation & repair.
7.	Opening of Agriculture Extension Centre at Chali Gach & seed store Fertilizers etc. as Trigam Block.
V	Any major complaint brought to notice:
1.	Non correction of Revenue records of Public land which is pending since long by Revenue authorities.
2.	Frequent disruption of water supply & contamination of PHE.
3.	NO NET Connectivity.
VI	Overall assessment of visit (Public Services): Please mention best practices, if any, observed
	Raised farming adopted by the Public & vegetable crops cultivation, Dairy Farming, Sheep & goat rearing was encouraged. They were made aware of organic farming & marketing to get maximum benefits.
VII	Overall assessment of visit (Panchayat Functioning):
	Majority of the Public in the Panchayat is aware about Panchayat activities, schemes of different Govt. Beneficiaries schemes but still need lot of education awareness exposure to still do better as per their potential.
