## NOTES

- ① During the official visit of visiting officer along with the front line workers, it was found during on spot verification that NTPHC Building Dehambel has defunct bathrooms, window panes, defunct Tiles, defunct septic tanks. While talking with Dr. Barhan, who told us that the work done by contractor is not satisfactory, they feel unsafe in the building. Dr. So along with the local people told visiting officer that the building has yet not been handed over to the health dept., they stressed that the building has not been constructed in a proper way, so bill amount for it should be reduced. The locals of gram panchayat requested visiting officer that the road of Police Station should be shifted to other direction, as people suffer badly. This problem should be resolved immediately.
- ② There is urgent need of 150<sup>th</sup> electric poles (HT poles) and wire for them. Urgent need of 500 meter pipes. ③ Library of Gram Panchayat should be upgraded, needs internet daily news papers & magazine facility. ④ Urgent need of 5 LEDS centres, 11 transformers 15 Ashes worker. ⑤ Urgent need of Public Park at Bir Malhela.
