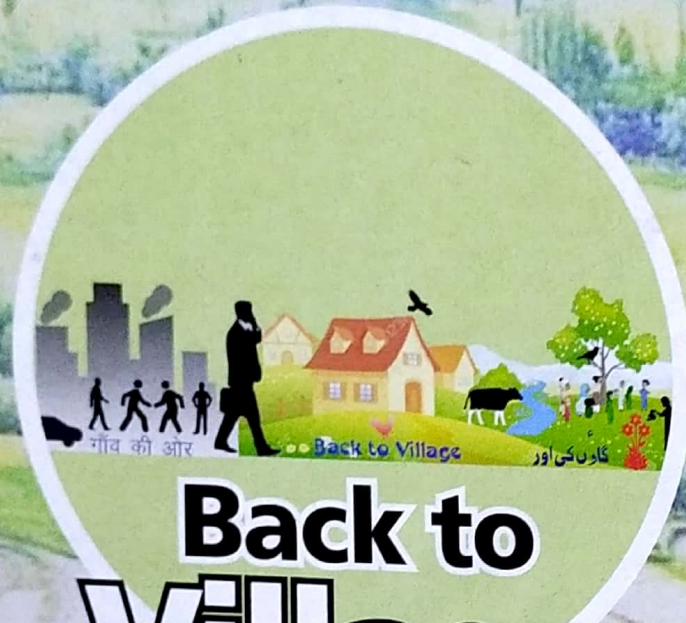

Slow pace of work on Karol-Badhat road has stalled the overall progress of the area, e.g. WSS delayed affecting all the hamlets of panchayat. What at Upper Kandini has got damaged and the same could be repaired only when the road project is completed, this Khul serves as the life line for the residents of Upper Kandini.
