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- IV Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07)
1. Village Behak Saba, which is about 9 km away from G.P. of Hammande & cut off due to unavailability of connecting roads should be declared as a backward village and delimitation of the G.P. should be done so as to transfer the village Behak Saba i.e. Ward no. 3 to nearest G.P. namely Manghar. Residents of this village were vehemently demanding the backward status and a connecting road be built. Behak Saba village is completely ignored on all fronts.
 2. Isolated & isolated hamlets be connected by construction of roads.
 3. Immediate attention be given to repair & revamp of electric poles & wires.
 4. Irrigation of land & drinking water facilities.

V Any major complaint brought to notice:

Village Behak Saba (Ward no. 3) of G.P. Should not have been in the jurisdiction of C.P. Hammande because this village is about 10 kms from the Hammande. It is the last hamlet in the area & should have been a backward village. The village is adjusted to near by G.P. i.e. Manghar.

Visiting officer is satisfied with the visit & cooperation of local people & Panchayat members was appreciable. Women participation in Panchayat is praiseworthy but they need to remove the cloak of introversion & start to express.

Panchayat functioning is satisfactory. Panchayat GPs need to be built & members of G.P. should play active part in different works. Also, they should communicate the information to the administration & local people.
