- III. ① Encroachment of Irrigational Canal running from Khader Moha. to Kandigal upto Hamdania Pulpai has been made by way of construction of Road across the paddy land, and has hampered irrigation to a large chunk of paddy field. The Problem of encroachment and its consequences were raised in the presence of M E, irrigation, Sh. Haris Jatoor, who responded very poorly in the front of The Gram Sabha Conducted on 27.6.2019.

During the meeting of Gram Sabha, it was reported, that the Compensation received against the grazing land (Section 4) acquired by various departments viz ^{NHA} (Town Planning, ^{Highway} Railway, etc) has not been utilised for the Community benefit, as envisaged under rules.

Demand for ~~established~~ establishment of a Public park was raised during the meeting of G. Sabha, for which land falling under khasra No: 612/613, khewat No 1056, kotla No: 1311 has been identified.
