

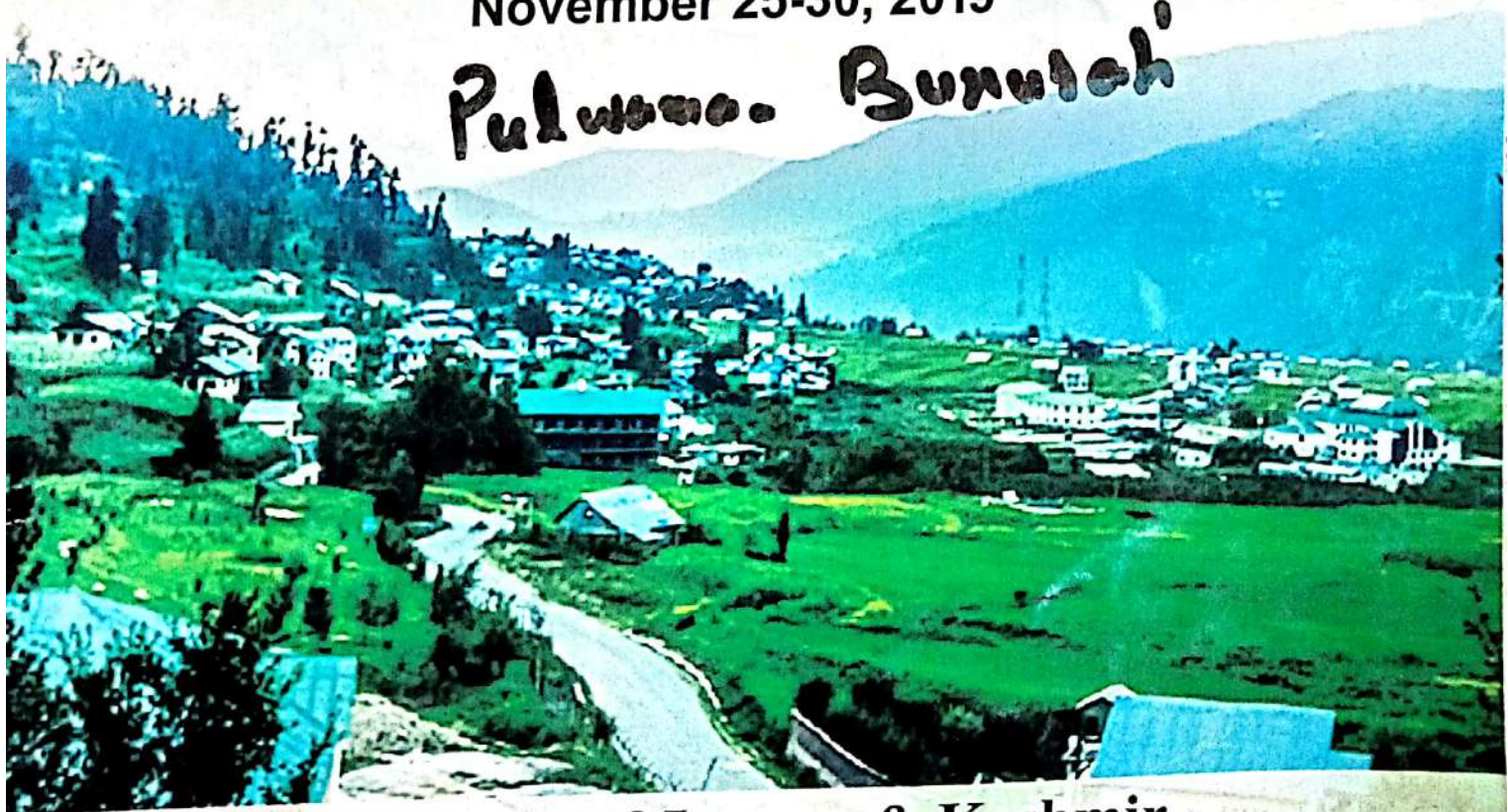

- I Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1. Lane from main road to Manzke Bandzo(A). Road from Dar mohle to Sheikh mohle Tandwal. Road Boonora To Sunsemil. Road from petrol pump to Bhat mohle and others Boonora. Road from Rajmahal to Asihah. Lane from Masjid to Bonpara Bandzo B. etc.
 2. UPS Bandzo(A) - upgradation, construction of second story and repairment. Middle school Boonora - Lawn development, boundary wall. High school Bandzo - Computer Lab, Lavatory. Primary Health center in Halda. Sport ground near bridge Bandzo.
 3. Jamia Masjid - Wazmuhle Bandzo(B) requires Drainage A Lavatory. Masjid Hapur Bandzo(B) needs Lavatory and Street lights. Masjid - Boonora needs Lavatory, street lights near petrol pump. Jamia masjid Bandzo(A), Masjid Mukdam mohle - requires Street lights and Lavatory.
 4. Desilting - Pootladi - Bandzo(A). Manzke kul - Bandzo A. Baghi Ladi Tandwal. Ayat Lad. Hadam Lad. etc.
 5. Electric Transformers, wires and poles requires in Rajmahal, Tandwal Bandzo(A+B) and Boonora. Urgent requirement in Ayat & Tandwal Sheikh mohle.
 6. Protection Bund to SASARA near High school and in an opposite bank from Bridge to middle school Bandzo(A). Protection Bund to Badi Kul.
 7. Water supply shortage in Panchayat Halda - needs Bore wells and water tanks to already established Tubewell in Teng mohle Bandzo(A). Public park near ziyat shreef Rajmahal. Wazmahle gate yard fencing in Bandzo(B).

II Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

- Shortage of Economic as well social infrastructure
- All demands in (B2V1) not addressed, people feel mockery
- Health sector needs to establish PHCs.
- Construction/development of Lanes/Link roads/Drainage in all the (04) villages of Halda required
- People feel no hope that their demands will be addressed
- Water and electricity shortages hamper functioning.
