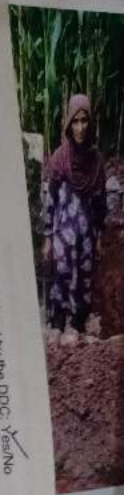

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
	<u>Tourism</u>:- GP is the way of famous spots such as Gurdwara Nangali Sahib as well as Zayarat Sain Anwar Din and Sain Miran Bakash. The Pilgrims from India as well as foreign countries visit there. So it is important to develop the GP which also improve the economy and underdeveloped conditions of the GP. 1. Most of the ward in GP are not connected to roads. They required roads for carrying the patients for treatments to the cities and for other purposes. Mostly people walk by foot to go to their homes that is basic needs to connect the GP link/internal roads. 2. Road from W.No.7 "Bawali Mohallah Naya'en" to Bhutli upper Nangali Sahib of approx 5km to connect almost all the wards in the GP. Road from Bawali to Dheri Sahib which is the basic need of Pilgrims as well as tourist to "Nangali Sahib Dargah" and also help for celebrating their religious functions. 3. Most of the public requirements for Patwar khana, Schools, in each and every ward and AW centers along with buildings. 4. Need of Bank Branch as well as ATM in Panchayat Nangali Sahib because large numbers of Yatries visit in this GP, that is why the GP needs bank branch for withdrawal and deposit their money. 5. 	<u>ROAD CONNECTIVITY</u> Climatic Conditions effects the roads and serve to make the construction of roads difficult and expensive. Some times the Govt. does not spend great sum of money to clear and re-build the road. Even if roads are constructed, connectivity to this GP get disrupted due to heavy snow fall and landsliding destroyed the road traffic and roads face the total erosion. The Govt. ought to pay more attention to develop the road connectivity and to develop the economy of this Panchayat.
