

L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
	Construction of embankment (Bund) from Gochal Tangpura to Rakhi-Haygam to prevent vulnerability of Gosam Panchayat floods. Setting up of De-watering Pump Elected.
	2. Immediate functioning of already existing Health Sub-center. Posting of adequate Medical/Para medical staff and should be equipped with all modern facilities and ambulance.
	3. Macadamization of damquishing road Project from Ambaspore to Haritar. Immediate Macadamization of all the dilapidated main and link roads of Gosam Panchayat.
	4. Rehabilitation of the people of the gosam panchayat from flood prone zone to safer zone. Settlement of Rakhi-Land.
	5. Construction of building for Government Primary school. Wandakpura Rakhi-Haygam which is presently operating in a Panchayat ghar.
	6. Construction of Gate wall on Kamichama Nallah to prevent vulnerability of GP to floods. Upgradation of Boys High School Radhagam to Higher Secondary.
	7. Construction of Community Hall. Which can be used for rehabilitation/shelter during disaster/natural calamities as the area is highly flood prone.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	Immediate Development of link road from Wandakpura Jamia Masjid to House of Mohammad Yusuf Dar on Panchayat. Immediate requirement of Two 100 Kw Transformers for Radhagam Lawampura and Haktange Aakhpura. 100 Low Tension Poles needed for Kalo Mohalla to Aakhpura.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	Government is functioning exceptionally well. except few departments like Flood Control, Irrigation Fisheries Fisheries department has a major role to play in bringing awareness among the masses of Guam Panchayat about the various departmental Welfare Scheme. As the majority cohorts of the population is earning their livelihood from Fisheries and are living below poverty line.
