
III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Overall perception of government functioning is satisfactory but non-availability of administrative has hampered functions of the panchayat. Needs to be resolved.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The govt. functionaries provided full support as there is need from different departments for making people aware about the schemes which may increase their income through workshops/camps besides providing basic infrastructure to the beneficiaries to be covered.
