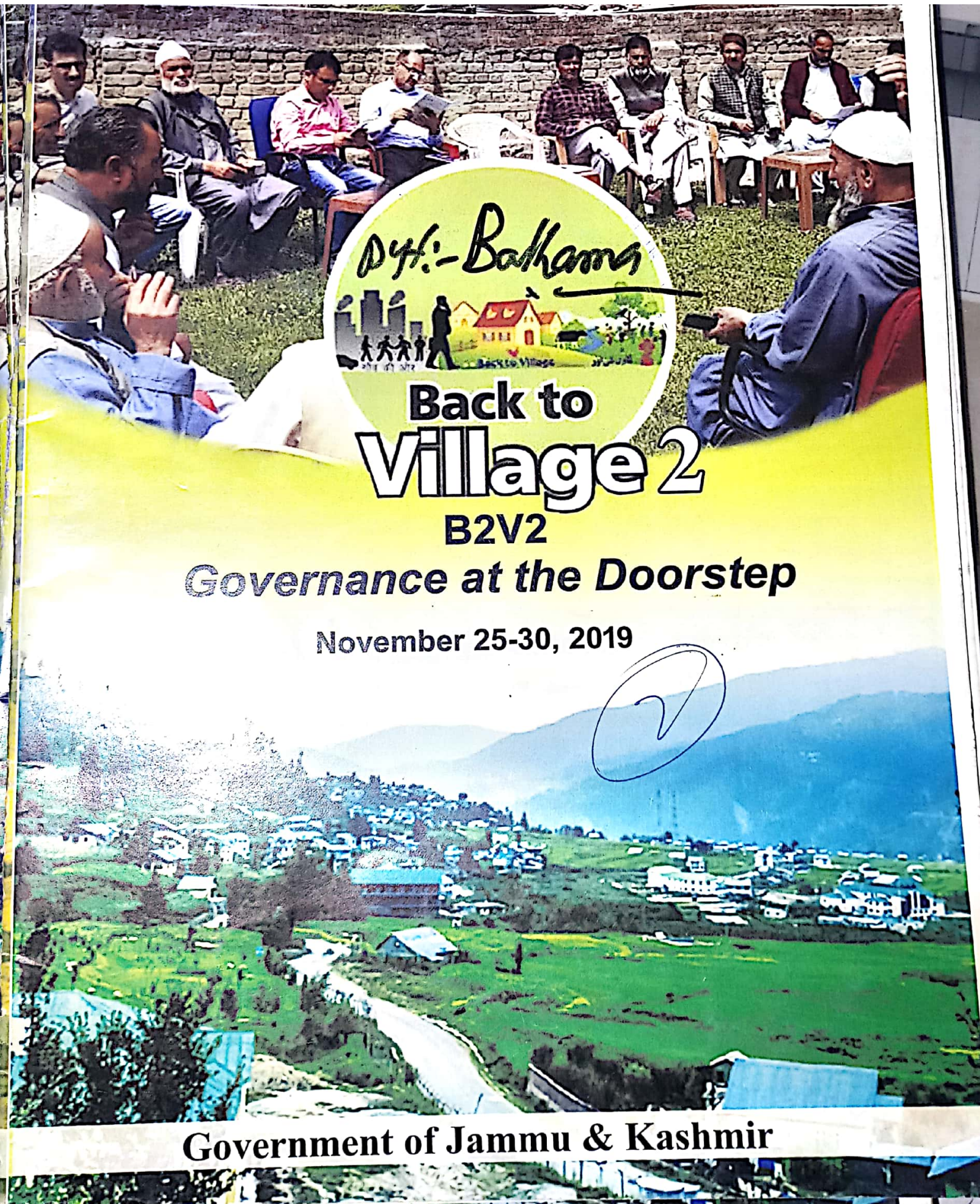

7.	Water Reservoir tank (20,000 Gallon)
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

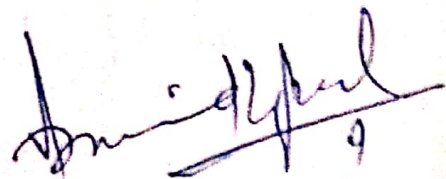
The people has generally good perception regarding the functioning of the government departments. The best performing departments are ROP, Education and Health Dept. However, they have better experience of Power Development Dept.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

As far as B2V₂ is concerned, there was a cold response from the inhabitants of the Halqa due to non-execution of works approved during B2V₁. The works approved during B2V₁ should be executed as early as possible, so that the objective of the programme is achieved. Most of the departments actively participated in the B2V₂ programme. However, action should be taken against the employees of PDD and Social Welfare Dept because of their non-cooperation. The efforts of the staff of High School Balma in improving the result of Secondary level is highly appreciable. It has also been observed that efforts put forth by Asha workers and Anganwari workers in safe guarding the health and nutrition of women and children is also commendable.
