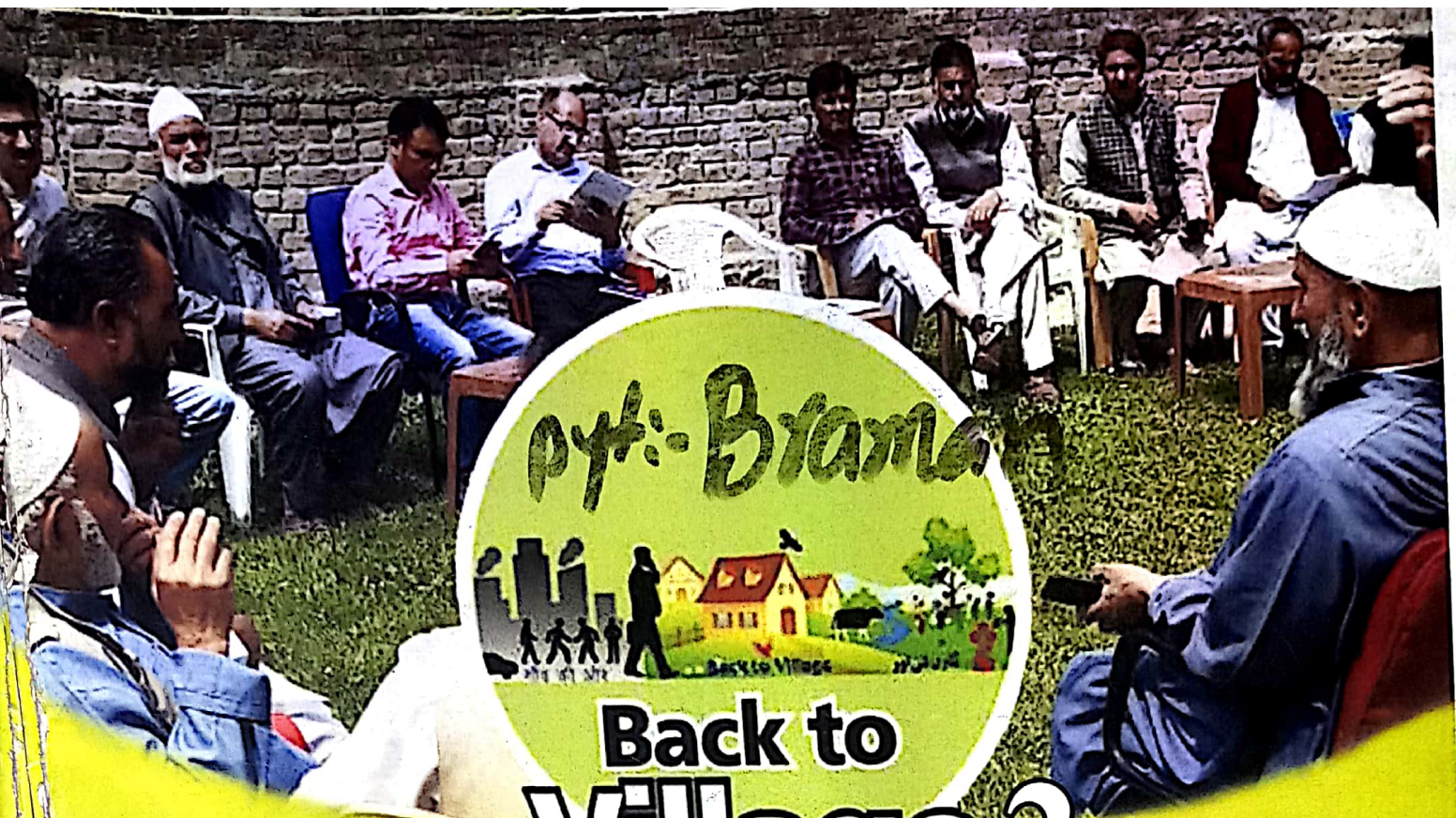


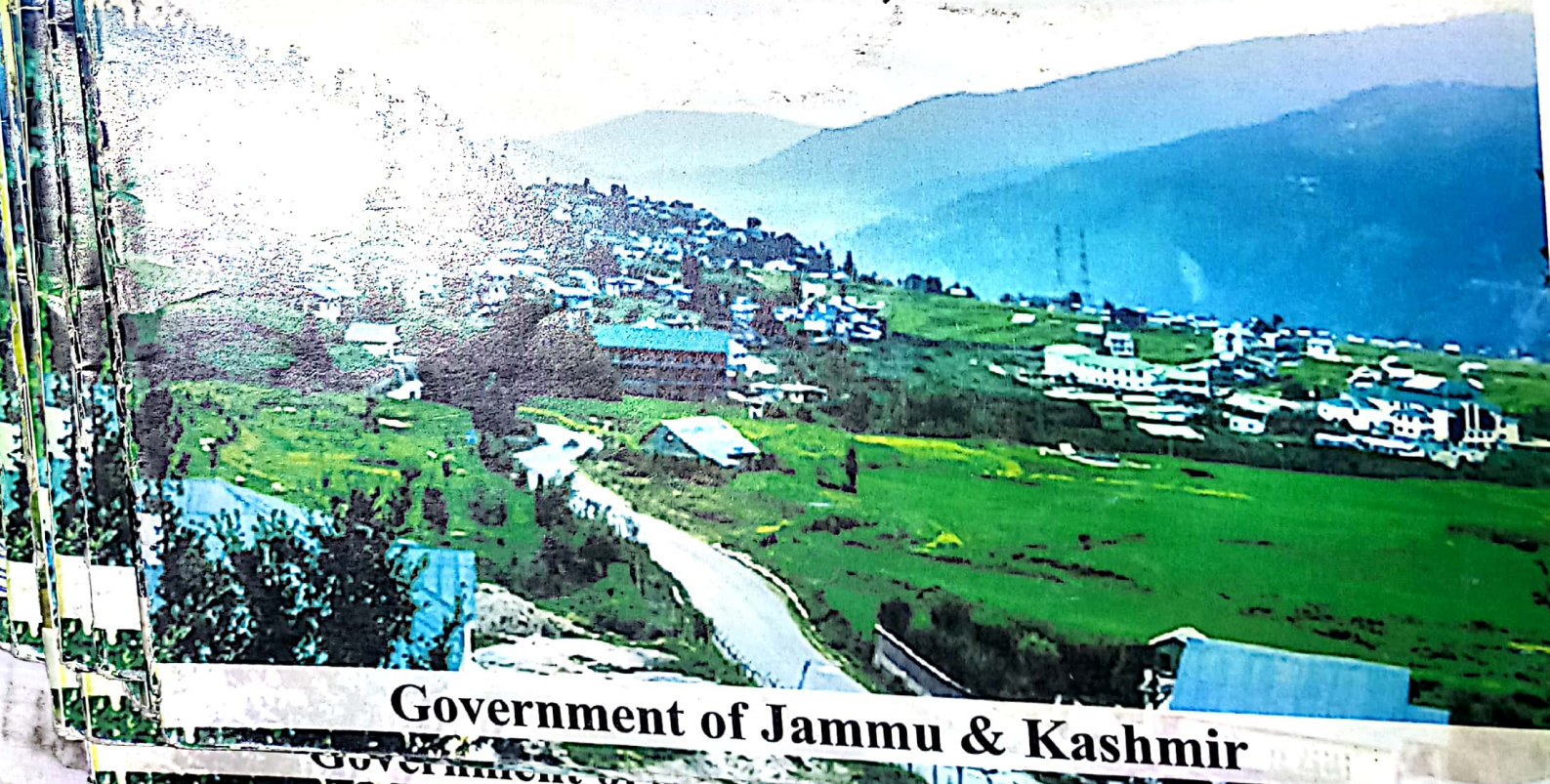

I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 10)
	Clean and hygienic drinking water facility to all households and all hamlets, including the 1st segment of Galibol.
	2. Upgradation of Subcentre to PHE provided with ambulance, and maternity services and adequate staff.
	3. Opening of Community Information Centre and Common Marriage Hall for the village.
	4. Covering of all elderly, widows, fatherless and disabled under pensionary schemes.
	5. Construction of Galibol to Kambay road bridge for all weather conditions.
	6. Opening of Girls Higher Secondary in Balamon and upgradation of existing primary schools. Besides, adequate toilet facility and fencing of Govt High School Balamon.
	7. Solar electricity for all households of the village.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	01. There is no nutrition supply in any of the two Anganwadi Centres of the Panchayat Nazim.
	02. Lack of ration store in Galibol.
	03. Lack of cellular network facility.
	04. Lack of all-weather road connectivity.
	05. Lack of six new electricity transformers.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	• People are generally unhappy with the functioning of the Government departments particularly those of RBB, PHE and PDD. RDD is well connected with the people and PRIs are actively engaged in the process of governance.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
	(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) The population of the village is extremely poor due to lack of educational infrastructure, geographical remoteness and employment opportunities. For bringing people out of poverty, Bgsia should be brought on tourist map and transport facility needs improvement. Moreover meadows and pastures of Braman and Lalital have the enormous potential for tourism. For tourism in the area has the capacity to effect growth in Braman.
