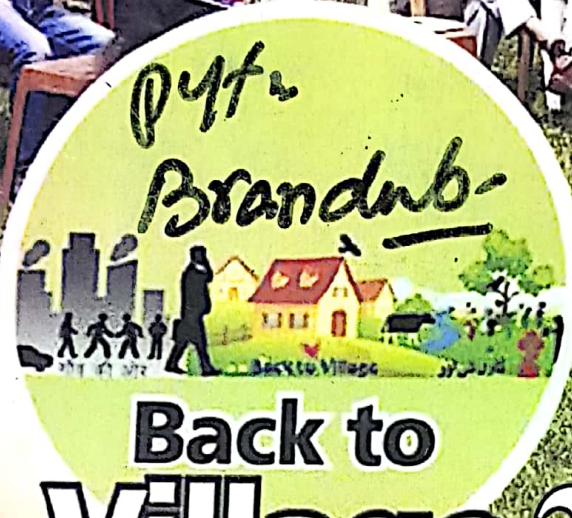
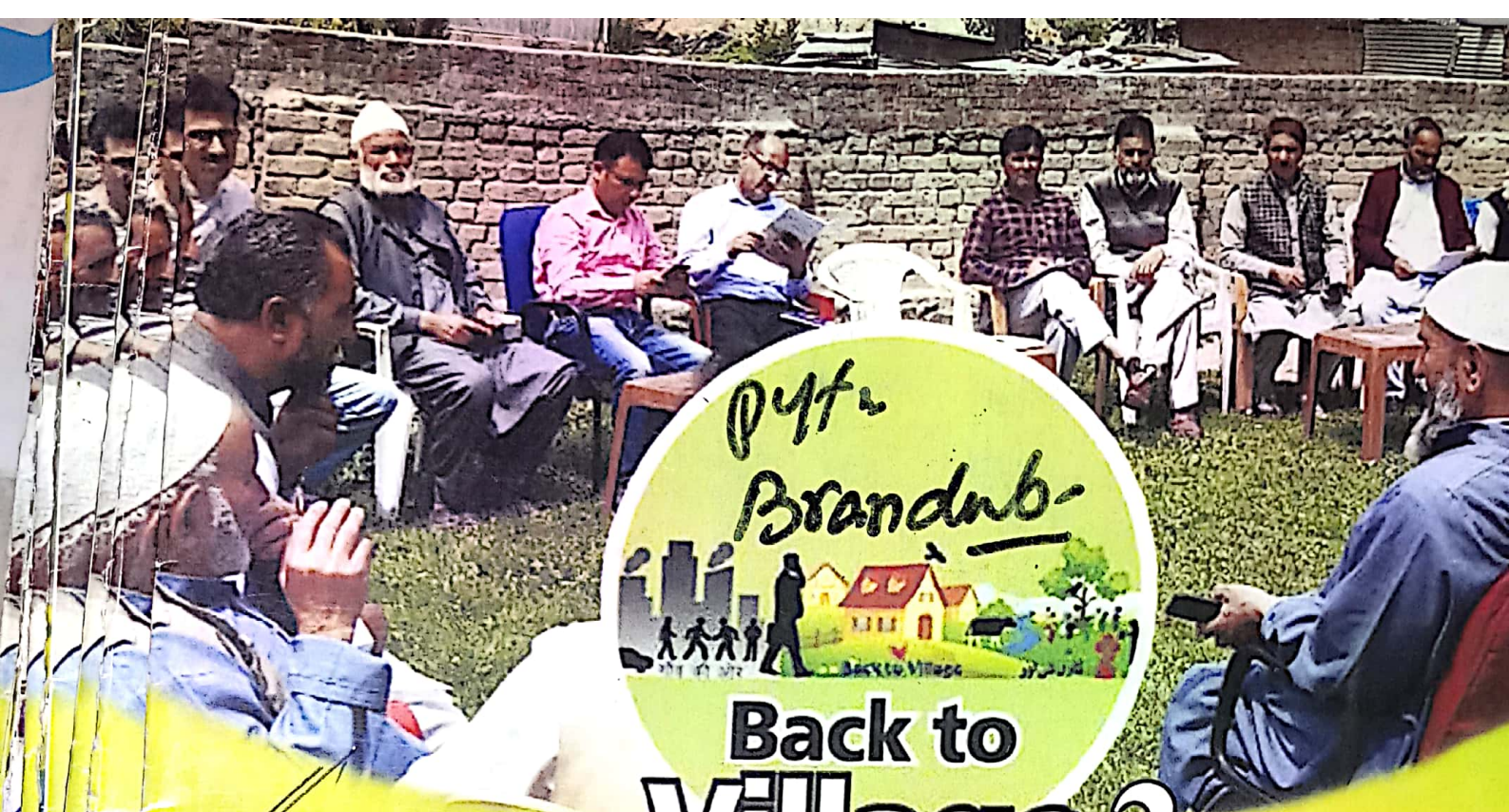




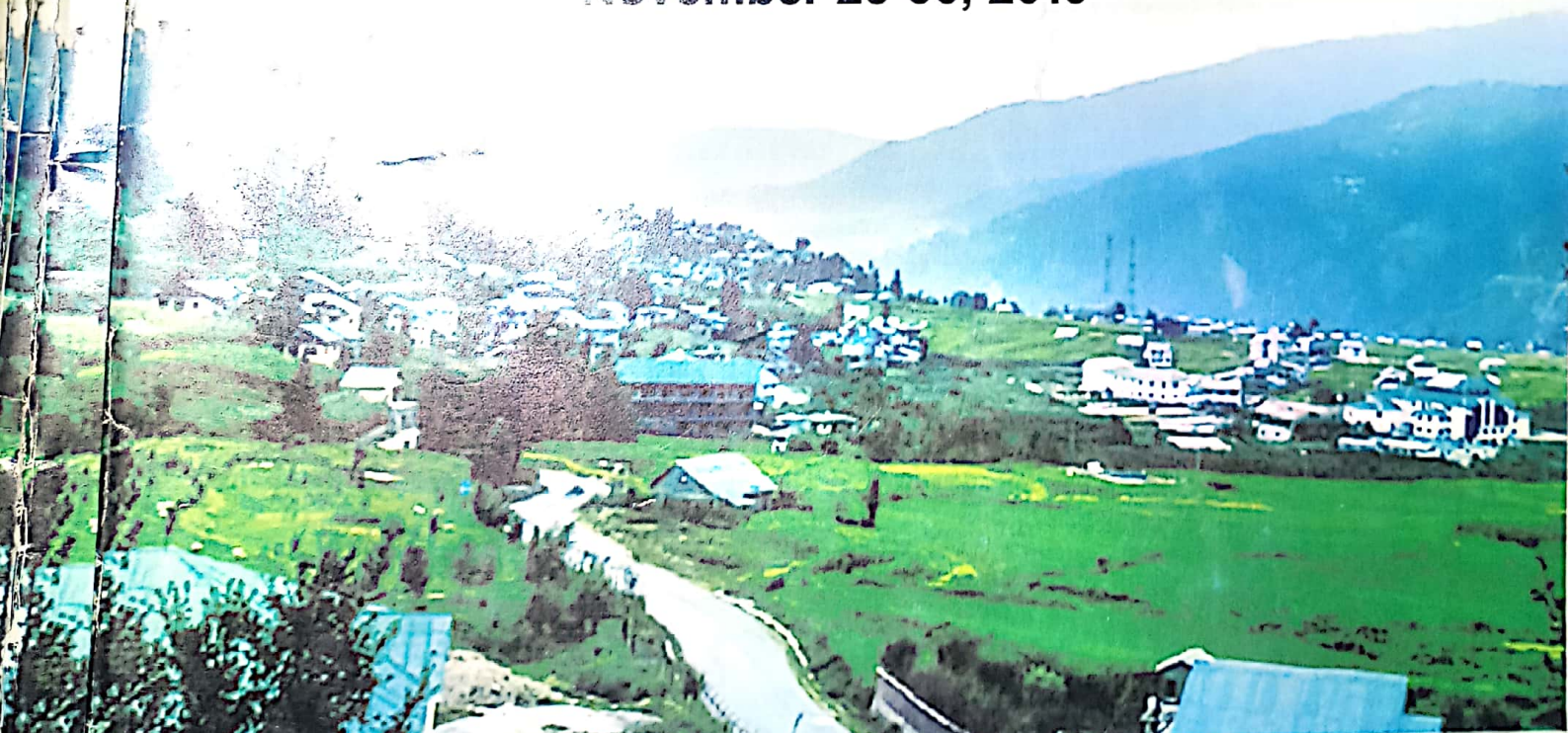

L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07).
	widening of main road from Bokarna to Baramunda 1. Water & drainage systems under C.P. maintenance, upgrade taking line roads via Kamari & Baramunda. Consider line roads Ward no. 4, 5, 6 & 7. Considering new road between Kamari & Baramunda. Protection works should be done provision of electric poles in both the villages. It 2. Kamari & Baramunda, seven transformers of 25 KVA & a be needed for the improvement of electrification for both the areas.
	Eight roomed building is needed for M/S Baramunda 3. to be constructed at forest land opp. to primary school. one phys school should be constructed for Kamari and deficiency of staff is to be fulfilled.
	Most priority of the people is better regulated drinking water supply. Because poor connectivity leads to age of pipes & want for replacement of old pipes. requirements of sub-reservoir of Baramunda village.
	Construction of protection walls / Berms is needed where sliding land / erosion happen for the safety of people & property.
	Opening of Agriculture office / Store, Horticulture 6. Store, Skill development centre, Jt. Bank Baramunda ATM facility, more ATMs, centres for Kamari area. Timber / fire wood sale dept. community hall. Upgradation Sub Health centre to PHC. Local Ambulance facility. one M.B.B.S doctor is needed for satisfaction of the people. Panchayat Akh is needed to be compelled.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
1)	Shortage & lack of water supply. 2) Public transport & availability of public Transport. 3) Dilapidated major roads including chune links. 4) non payment of installment of tax & insurance.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

The people feel that the promises regarding accountable and transparency of the govt is being found very poor on the ground. Though the panchayat functioning play vital role in inculcating democracy from the grass root level, but the people feel neglected when they are not in the decision making process of different times. The result of this opens up for people in losing confidence towards the govt.

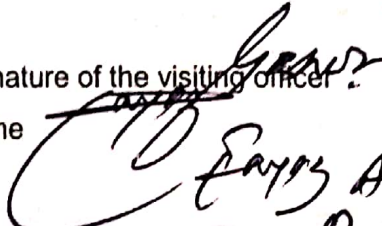
IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
