III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

All the departments are working with dedication especially people are praiseworthy for RDD, Agriculture and ICDS. Anganwadi worker and daily wagers complained that they have not been paid honorarium/wages for the last nine months. Most of the people complained for non availability of funds in RDD, Social Welfare PHE, PDD and ICDS Departments as all the assurances made in B2VI have not been fulfilled till date.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

Being a hilly and Backward area majority of people are poor, unemployed and come under BPL category. Only one crop of maize is grown annually due to severe cold. The main source of livelihood is agriculture and labour. The youth of the panchayat have strongly demanded for construction of Community centre and playground. There is dire need of High/Higher Secondary School as majority of girls leave their studies after passing Middle. Majority of people have demanded for plantation of fruit/mulberry trees and provision of bee hives to enhance their income resources. There is also a great potential for rearing of livestock as most of the panchayat area is covered with thick forests. Small scale units are also essential to meet out the unemployment problem. There is need of promoting Tourism as Mughal Road passes through the panchayat and many beautiful spots waiting to be developed for tourism.
