I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1	Funding to GP is grossly inadequate under 14th FC need to be enhanced to create tangible assets.
2	Main road of GP from Highway to firing range (1000m) is with NER, should be transferred to HOD/MD for its better maintenance.
3	Since every household has cattle population, the GP has strong demand for a veterinary centre.
4	Due to inadequate piped water connection, there is a need to have 4-5 hand pumps to remove water scarcity.
5	Add funds (around 10 lacs) needed for completion of under construction community hall. Besides provision of funds be made for an additional community hall.
6	Funds amounting to 4.0 lacs needed for two sanitation complexes. No funds provided for liability of JHH in respect of 120 units.
7	Internal roads are in need of black topping and abgradation by means of drainage. (least work to prevent their degradation & loss of fertile land).
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
1	Unscientific mining needs to be checked as it is damaging agricultural lands/irrigation channel/lowering water table.
2	Cases of old age widow/PMC pension not sanctioned for last many years.
3	No funds provided under P&AP, though area falls in the B&P belt.
