

IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

	Work needs to be done at ground level with good pace. It is suggested that basic facilities like communication, water, electricity be provided so that seasonal migration can be stopped, as whole of Poshama having about 800 households migrate to other places due to harsh conditions.
