Keeping in view of BTV, no demand of the EP has been fulfilled by DC P. against the promise given been done. No development work has been done for hauled Hill wanchi ward, Mohala. chichi Mohala & Kales Mohala. The EP Drabharan was not to be completed.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Most of the GP (Dankharan) is suffering from basic facilities like drinking water, road facility, drains, parks, play ground and irrigation facilities.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

The U/Sd is not in a position to assess the progress of the developmental works of the GP keeping in view the recommendations of BZVI because the district in general witnessed a complete lull for more than two months. Also this GP has not been given any approval for one of the recommended works due to unknown reasons. The GP being hilly, has remained unattended during the past. Special attention is needed for the development of this GP keeping in view the approval & release of funds. People are co-operating in the work. Special attention from the governmental machinery is needed. Frontline workers deputed to BZV programme must be other than class-IVs.

The U/Sd once again recommends the construction of bridge on Nalla Romshi near P/S wanchi wada, construction of bund on Nalla Romshi along village wanchi wada, improvisation/upgradation of roads, Lt & Ht lines. P/S Dankharan be upgraded as H/school having feasibility in all respects. The delegations from the GP have pressed upon the said demands.
