

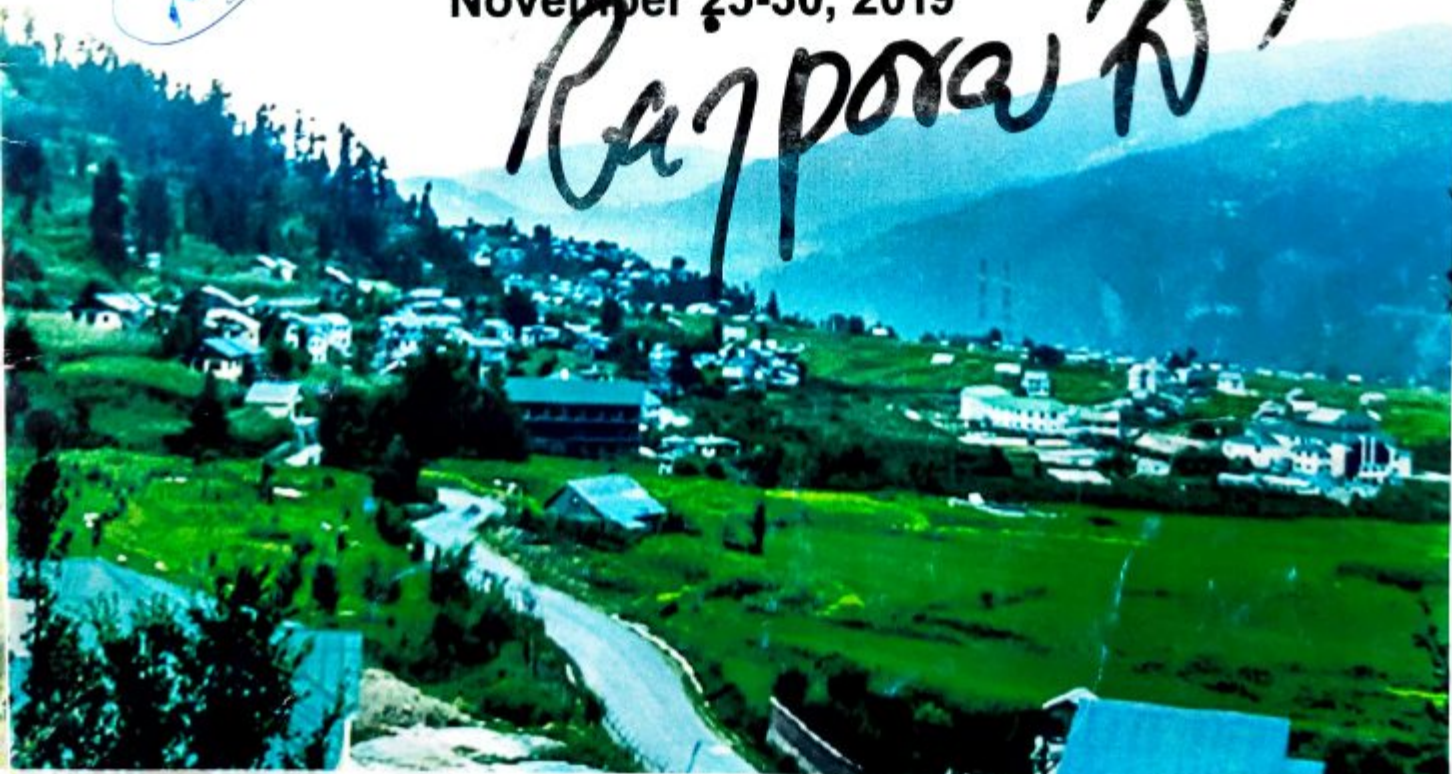

3. Improvement of WTLT in the Panchayat Halga and the installation of LT line from BSNL Exchange to Mo. Sub. Station at Rajpora.

4. Demand of Ganga Station in the Panchayat Halga.

5. Project has been submitted to Flood Protection works in Eastern Wallah from Dargah to Rajpora the project has not been started yet. The project should be started at earliest.

6. Repair of water pipes.

7. Distilling of Stream passing through GHSS Rajpora.

- II Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

1. Erratic Power Supply.

2. Worst condition of road from Main Slip Rajpora to CHC Rajpora.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
