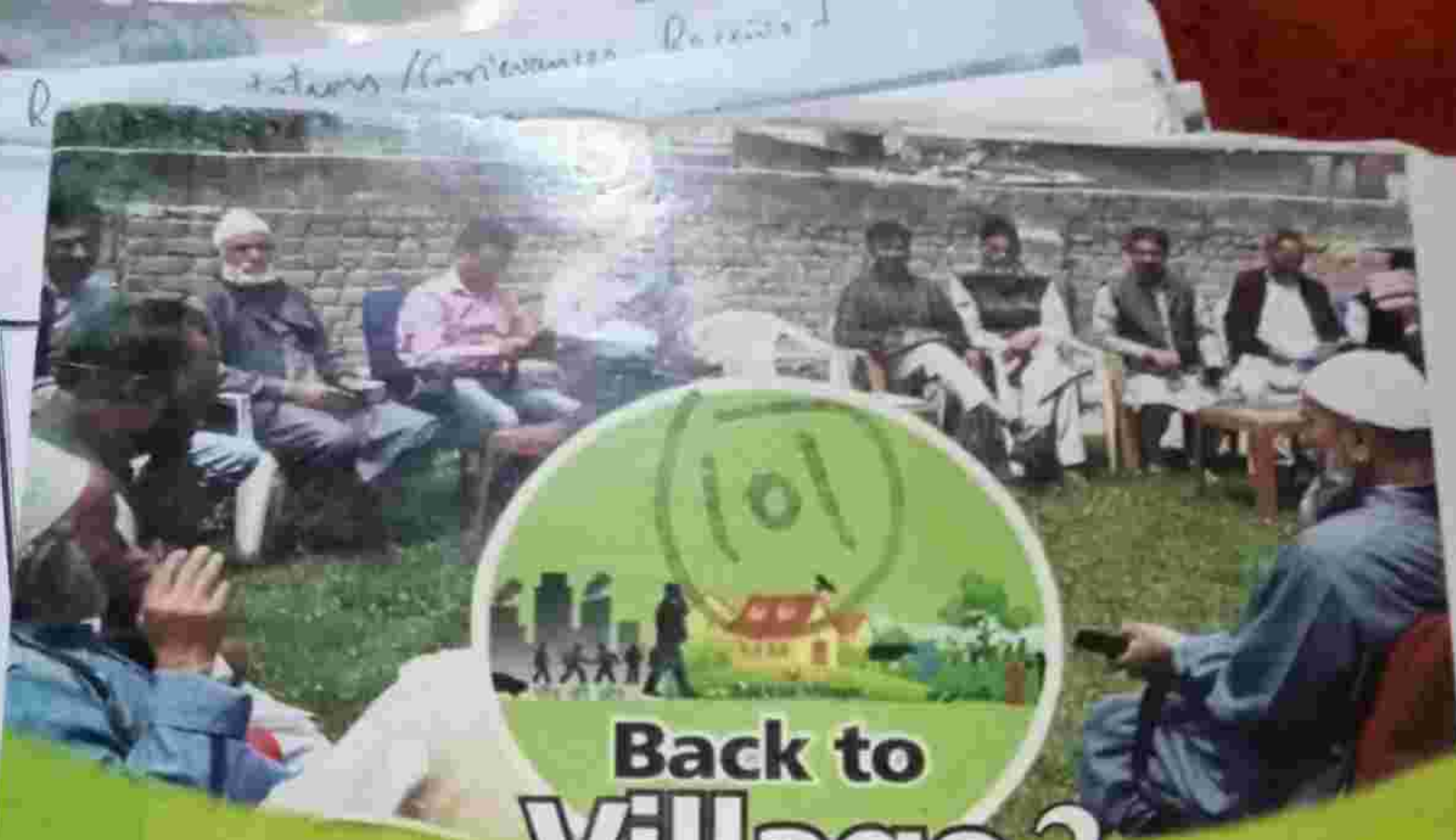




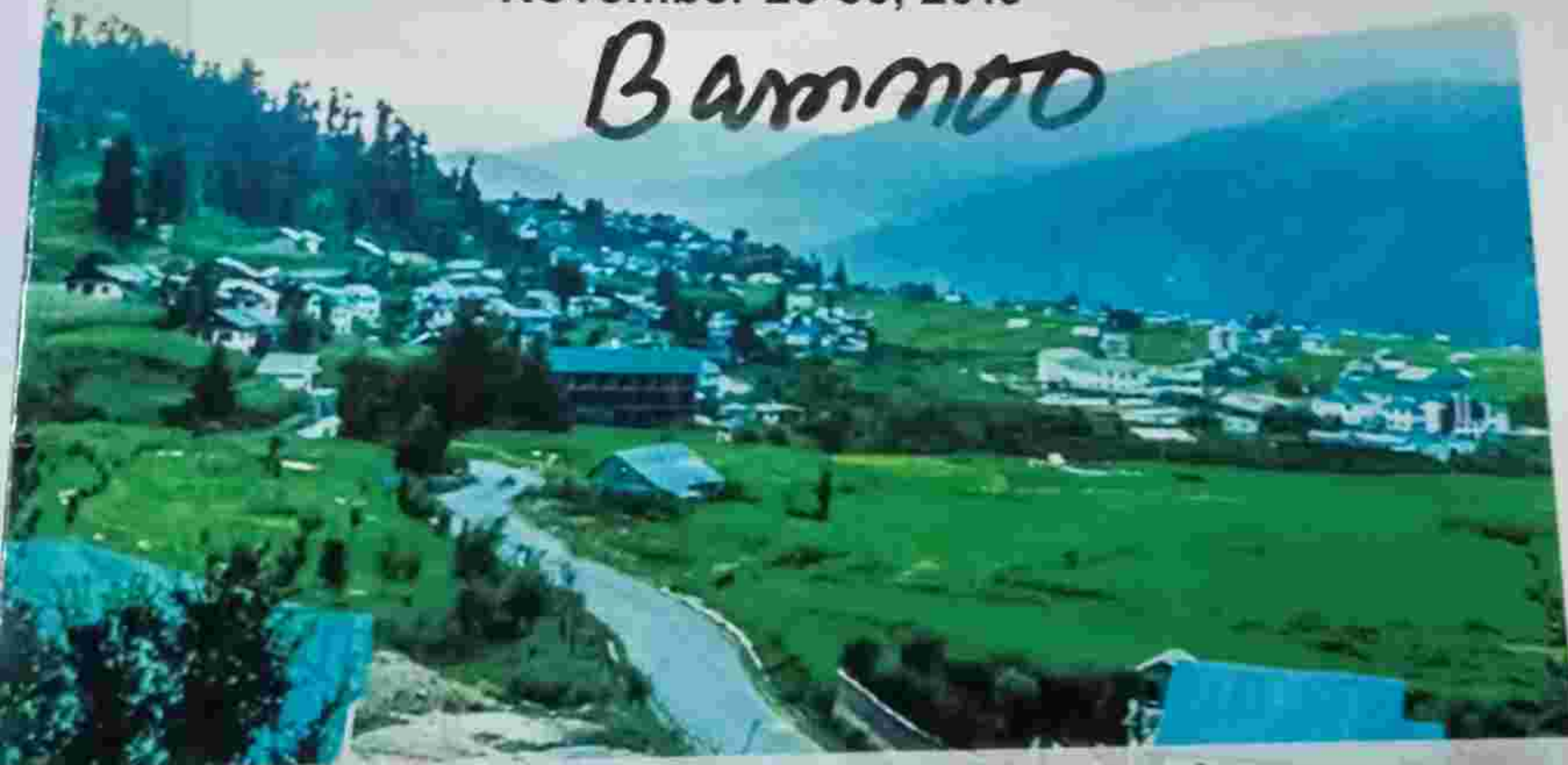

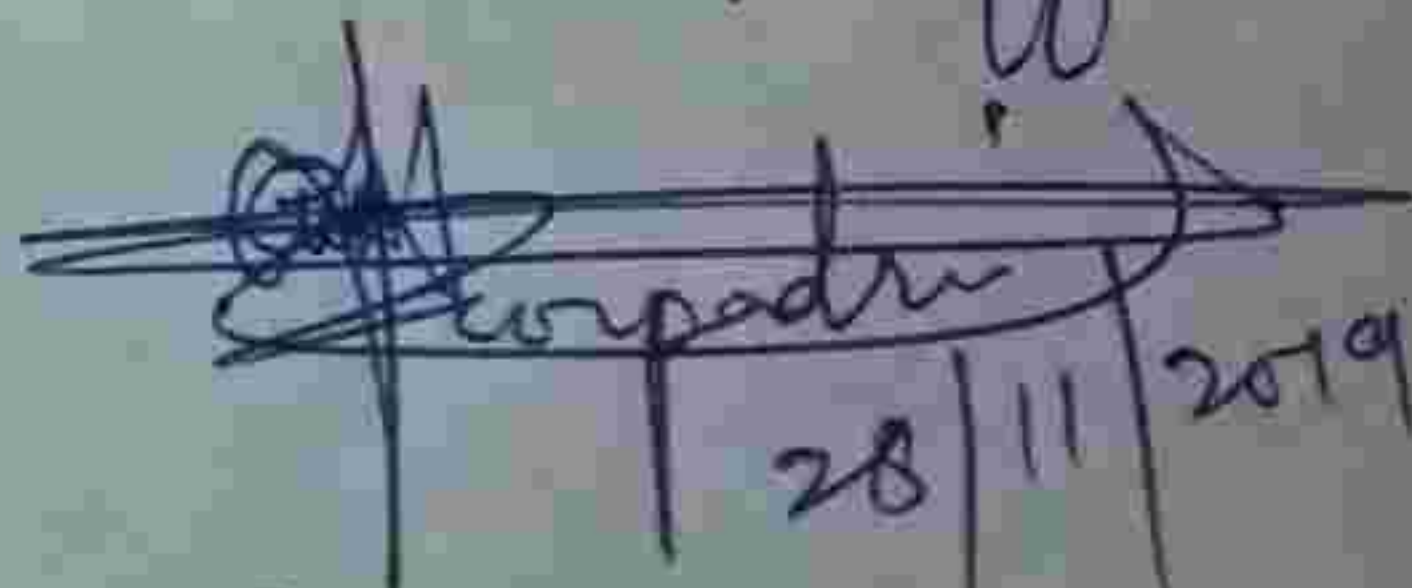
IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

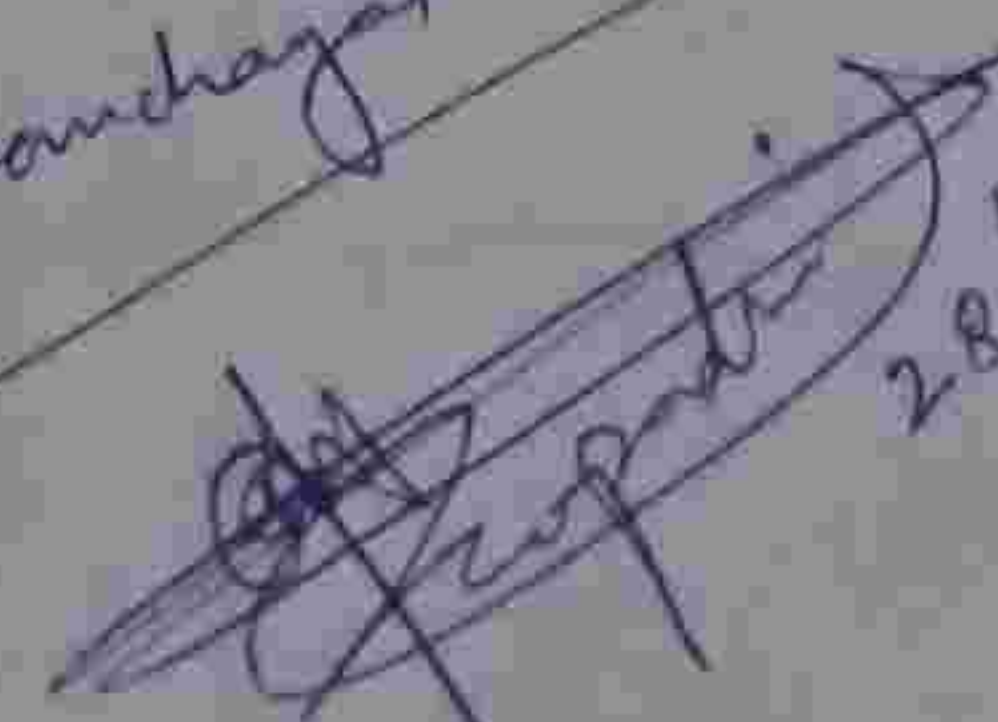
