Undaunted by the skeptics and the programme exceeded our own expectations. Everywhere the visiting officers were welcomed, feted and honoured. The affection and respect with which officers were received across geographies was, for us, a testimony to the innate goodness and hospitality of the common people. The officers spent two days and a night with the people-tiving with them, eating the same food, and learning first hand the challenges and difficulties of their existence. For many it was a unique learning experience, the aweet fore of nature brought home to them the beauteous forms of things; for others was a humbling experience as it laid bare to them the dignity which the rural population types, notwith standing the mydiad challenges of their existence. White the first phase of the programme was focussed on collecting feedback and assessing needs, the second phase intends to look more closely at the task of empowering, energising and assistationalizing the functioning of Panchayati Raj Institutions invariably they will associate Pariches/Surpanches. The other objective of this edition of the programme will be to look at the various flagship programmes and individual beneficiary oriented achieves and from more about the impedments, prievances which tampers their full implementation and their disposal also be ascertained. General Instructions for the Visiting Officer Back to Village 2 (B2V2)

A suggested activity schedule has been prepared for the visiting officer. It shall be intumbered on the officer to sensure that all activities and elements mentioned in the schedule are carried outloovered fully.

The Valling officer shall note a meeting with the Deputy Commissioner of the deathd before undertaking the village visit. During the motion taken on the takens raised in the previous Back to Village visit in June and shall also be grown written booklets, figure and shall also be grown written.

Before undertaking the viest, officer must familiarise himself/herself with important schemes expectatly flagship schomes, rural income locussed programmes and individual beneficiary chemited programmes e.g. PM-Kissa, Dairy Entractaheurahip Development Scheme and Backyard Poulity Scheme, Pension Schemes etc. She/he must also be familiar with 14" FC, MDM and ICDS (rustralon component)

Drung his yest, the officer shall perticipate in the Gram Sabha, unyell the Gram Parichayat Development Plan (GRDP) and also wristure the constitution of vanous committees including Panchayat Blodiversity Committee.

Hershe shall hold detailed deliberations in the Gram Sabha about the issues raised in Back to Village 1 and the follow up action taken on the same by the district administration and the various line departments. Height shall also share the report card and critical gap analysis under Mission Arriyodaya prepared by the District Administration with the Gram Sabha.

The visiting officer strall distribute the information flyers regarding 100%, coverage of all beneficiary oriented schemes and also discuss the issue in the Gram Sabha, the will ensure that frontine workers accompanying him explain at least some of these schemes in detail to the people.

The officer should assess the level of functionality of the Panchayal, infrastructure available in the Panchayal, support provided to it by the officials and the difficulties belief faced by it in implementing various developmental othernes, for this purpose the should hold detailed meetings with Panchayal, rembers and also officials.

- The veited officer should try and visit as many local institutions including schools. PriCs. Angelowed Centres etc. in possible. His should also inspect at least some of the works carried outbeing certied out under various schemes like 14° FC. MNREGA and other government programmes. In case, there is a languishing project in the village, the officer should certainly inspect this same and record its progress.
- In addition to all other activities that the visiting officer will carry out the/she should the special emphasis on 100% enrolment of school children (age 4-14 years), 100% coverage of PM-Kisan, Ayushman Bhanat and 100% coverage of all beneficiary oriented schemes including penalons and schemethins. He she should also by to understand how various government programmes can be peter used for doubling rural incomes and energiating rural rural rural and willage industries.
- The visiting officer shall restrain Nimself-horself from giving or offening any commitment on behalf of the government.
- xi. The visiting officer shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his observations should be based on a consensual view unerging from his interactions in the village.
- xii. The report of the visiting officer shall be submitted both physically and electronically in the pre-circulated format. The officer should exercise all care and objectivity while filling up the same.
- xiii. After completing the village visit and before leaving the district, the officer must hold a debriefing meeting with the Deputy Commissioner and his/her team and deposit the B2V2 booklets and any other lists/applications/grievances that may have been handed over to him/her during the visit.

Suggested Activity Schedule for the Visiting Officer

Pre and Post Visit Activities

- Meeting with the Deputy Commissioner for collection of documents and briefing regarding the visit before going to the Panchayat.
- Debriefing meeting with the Deputy Commissioner and submission of one copy
 of the filled-in booklet and other papers before leaving the district.

Day 1

- Arrival in the Panchayat by 10 A.M. (capture picture).
- Attend the Gram Sabha;
 - Read out the charter of Fundamental Duties;
 - Discuss B2V1 report card, critical gap analysis report and obtain feedback on follow up of B2V1 activities.
 - Unveil the GPDP booklet in the Gram Sabha.
 - Get the resolution for approval of GPDP and MGNREGA passed in the Gram Sabha.
 - Unveil the 14th FC plan booklet in the Gram Sabha.
 - Inspect the four pass books: 14th FC, MDM, ICDS, Own Resources.
 - Check the purchase record register for MDM and ICDS.
 - Distribute the information flyers on Individual Beneficiary Based Schemes.
 - Fill up those columns of the B2V2 booklet which require Gram Sabha responses.
 - Distribute guidelines of government schemes which can help increase rural incomes e.g. Backyard Poultry, Dairy Entrepreneurship Scheme etc.
 - Get the Panchayat Biodeversity Committees constituted if not already constituted through a Panchayat (not Gram Sabha) resolution. The format for the resolution will be made available by the district administration.
 - Check Panchayat Asset register and infrastructure register. If the same is not available, the officer will get it prepared.

- Collect copy of Panchayat Plastic Collection and Disposal plan.
- Get scheme-wise list of individuals who are desirous of accessing individual beneficiary oriented schemes but have not applied so far.
- Collect any complaint/grievance that people may have, especially with regard to non-sanctioning of benefits under individual beneficiary oriented schemes.
- Get list of households without piped water/electricity connection,

Day 1 Afternoon:

- Visit local schools, health institutions, AWCs, government assets, banks, water bodies, tubewell, electric station, important private enterprises,
- Visit other villages in the Panchayat.
- Evening informal interaction with PRI representatives, frontline government functionaries and prominent citizens to discuss and deliberate upon the core problems/issues being faced by the locals of the Gram Panchayat and ways to increase rural incomes and energise village/micro industries.
- Capture evening interaction picture by 8.00 P.M.

Day 2:

- Capture morning picture at 7 A.M.
- Formal meeting with the Panchayat members:
 - Get various subjects/portfolios assigned to the panches by the Sarpanch if not already assigned and get a Panchayat resolution passed for the same.
 - Inspect the karwai register and make the Panchayat members aware about the requirement of monthly meetings as per the Act.
 - Check the digital signatures of Sarpanch/Panchayat
 Secretary/Administrator.
 - Assess the functionality of Panchayats and discuss the difficulties being faced by the Panchayat in carrying out its functions and development works.
- Formal interaction with:
 - Frontline government functionaries (Doctor/Teacher/Patwari/Anganwadi Workers/ASHAs/ANMs/VLW/PDS storekeeper/representatives of PHE, PDD, PWD, Agriculture, Animal Sheep, Horticulture etc.)
 - Social activists/NGOs.
 - Prominent citizens/retired teachers/Govt. employees/ex-servicemen etc.

- Visit the Panchayat Ghar/BDC office and check for furniture/computer.
- Install board at land identified for Panchayat Ghar.
- Lead Grah Pravesh Ceremony for completed PMAY houses.
- Inaugurate the previous B2V work and lay foundation stone for a new one.
- Inspect B2V1/14th FC works/Languishing works/other developmental projects taken up.
- Inaugurate the playground; lay the foundation stone for CSC, start one sports event.
