

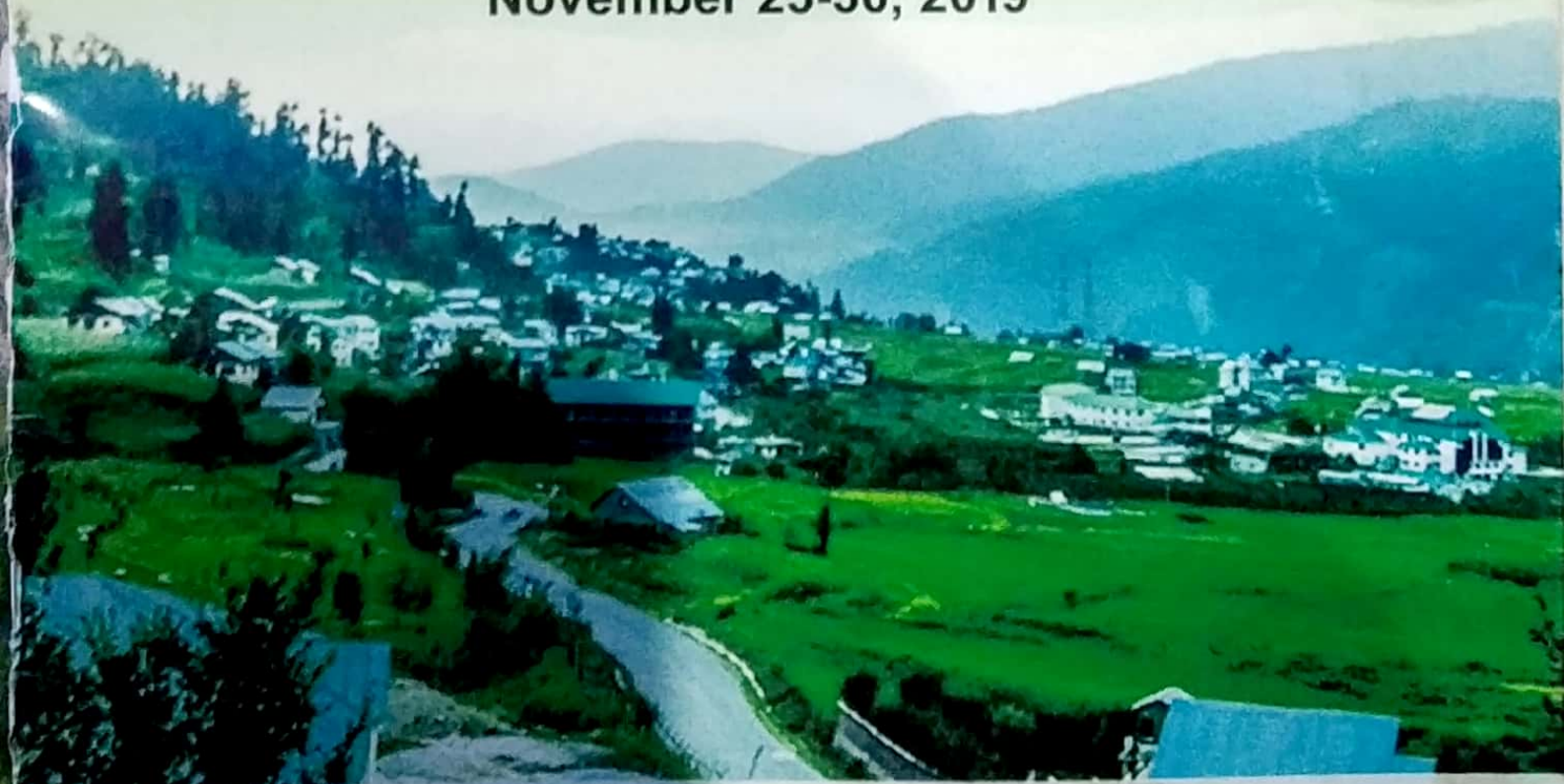

1.	<u>Irrigation</u> : Rainwater harvesting ponds / water percolation pits
2.	<u>Drinking water</u> : Taping of Spring at Bonchetre (Main) to regulate it as a source of drinking water by maintaining the Spring → Construction of Reservoirs
3.	<u>School</u> : Separate toilet for girl students at H.S. Dadpeth Provision of Computer Lab. Decision to be taken on damaged building of P.S. Lonepura.
4.	<u>Panchayat Ghar</u> : Presently under the occupation of Police Provision to establish office of PRI, alternate accommodation can be provided at H.S. Dadpeth (Old Bunkhy)
5.	<u>Play field</u> : Land required, State land near Idalgare — Repair of H.S. Dadpeth ground - Boundary wall to MS Wythame
6.	<u>Electric supply</u> : Electric poles & wire required of W.N.R. - 5 = 10, W.N.R. = 610 (to be replaced) W.N.R. 1 = 10 poles. Additional Transformer 25 KV at W.N.R. 5. Wythame
7.	Extension Counter of Food Supplies to Wythame of the Panchayat -
