I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	There is urgent need of electrification as 80% of the Panchayat is unelectrified
2.	There is urgent need of tap water facility as 100% households are without tap water
3.	There is need for rural road connectivity as 80% of Panchayat is without road connectivity
4.	There is urgent need for construction of Panchayat ehar for which land has been demarcated.
5.	There is urgent need of Primary Health centre as the condition of two sub-centres is very poor.
6.	There is need for setting of sub-centres of Sheep and animal husbandary / Horticulture, agriculture
7.	There is urgent need of regular visits of the officers of Social welfare and ICDS as most of the anganwadi centres are disfunctioning
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
1.	Electrification of Panchayat, as 80% of Panchayat is unelectrified
2.	Rural road connectivity as 80% of Panchayat is without road connectivity.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	As for as the functioning of the government is concerned there is lot of scope for good governance in the Panchayat as the inhabitants of the whole Panchayat have been ignored by the previous govt. functionaries. The finest example can be observed by the fact that 80% of the Panchayat is without electricity and tap water supply where head load is near about 1.5 kms.

	<u>Monitoring of Govt Projects and Schemes</u>
	There is urgent need for monitoring of Govt. sanction projects in the Panchayat. As there are various Projects of Govt. whose work has been started but are stopped in the middle of the project. Example is PHC at Simbol, Panchayat Lhar at Gwari and recently the work allotted under B2V-I for which funds stands released is yet to be started
