

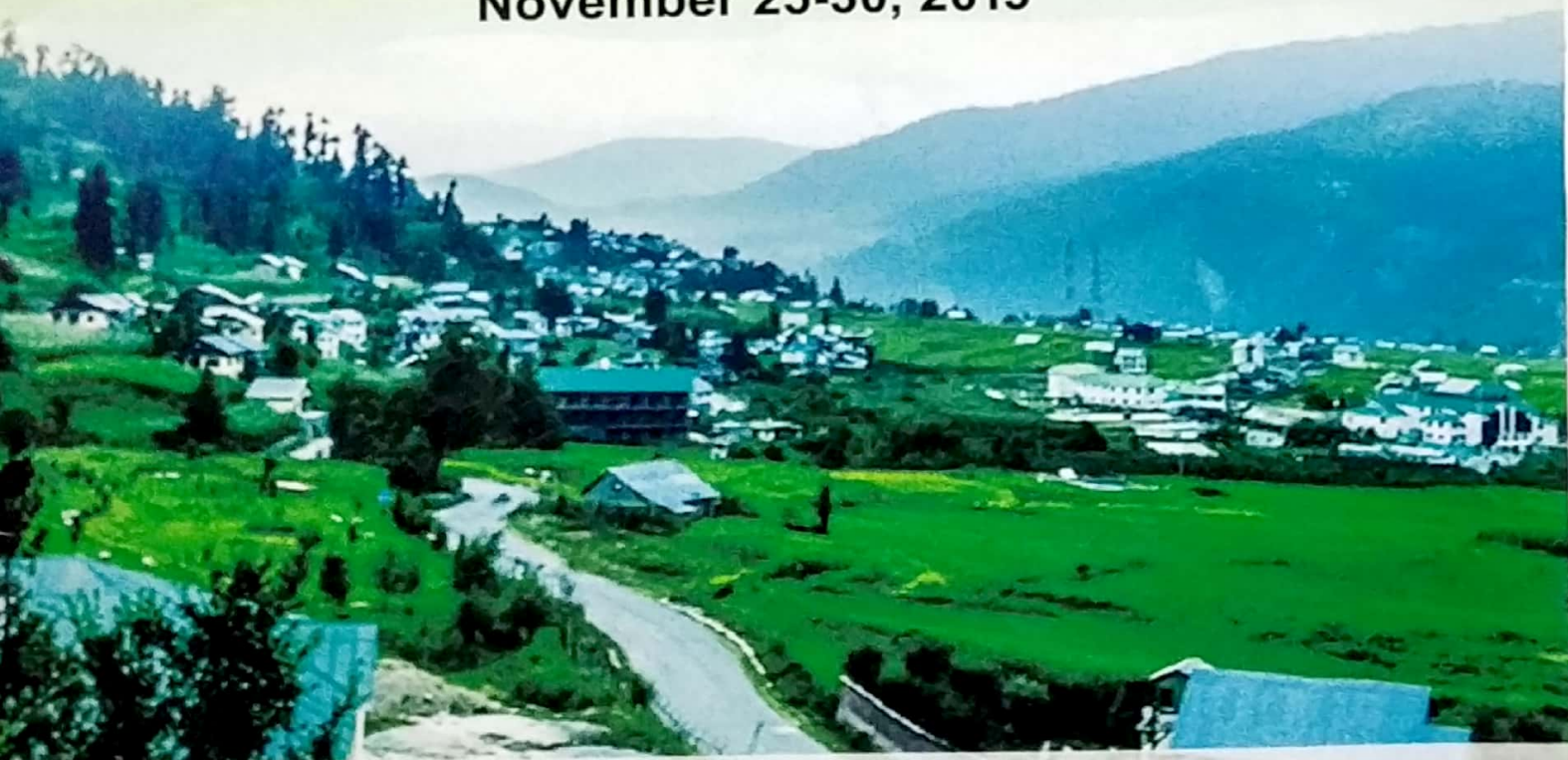

	7. Requirement of High School.
