

II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
①	People/Rustic of Panchayat not satisfied with Road Survey Sree to Balana 5km onwards which needs to be done again as most of the houses are coming under alignment especially of SC's.
②	Water connection to each household to be provided.
③	Compensation of Land/structure/tree not paid by R & B (PWD) for Road Sree to Balana 1-4km

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	There is a lot of scope of improvement in every Public Sector & Services. There is acute shortage of staff in most of the Govt. Departments due to which the departments are not able to cover, deliver, implement all the schemes to each & every Panchayat of the Block.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

	The newly elected PRI's are functioning well but most of them are not aware of the most of the basic schemes of the Governments for which regular training/awareness camps should be organised at Panchayat levels.
