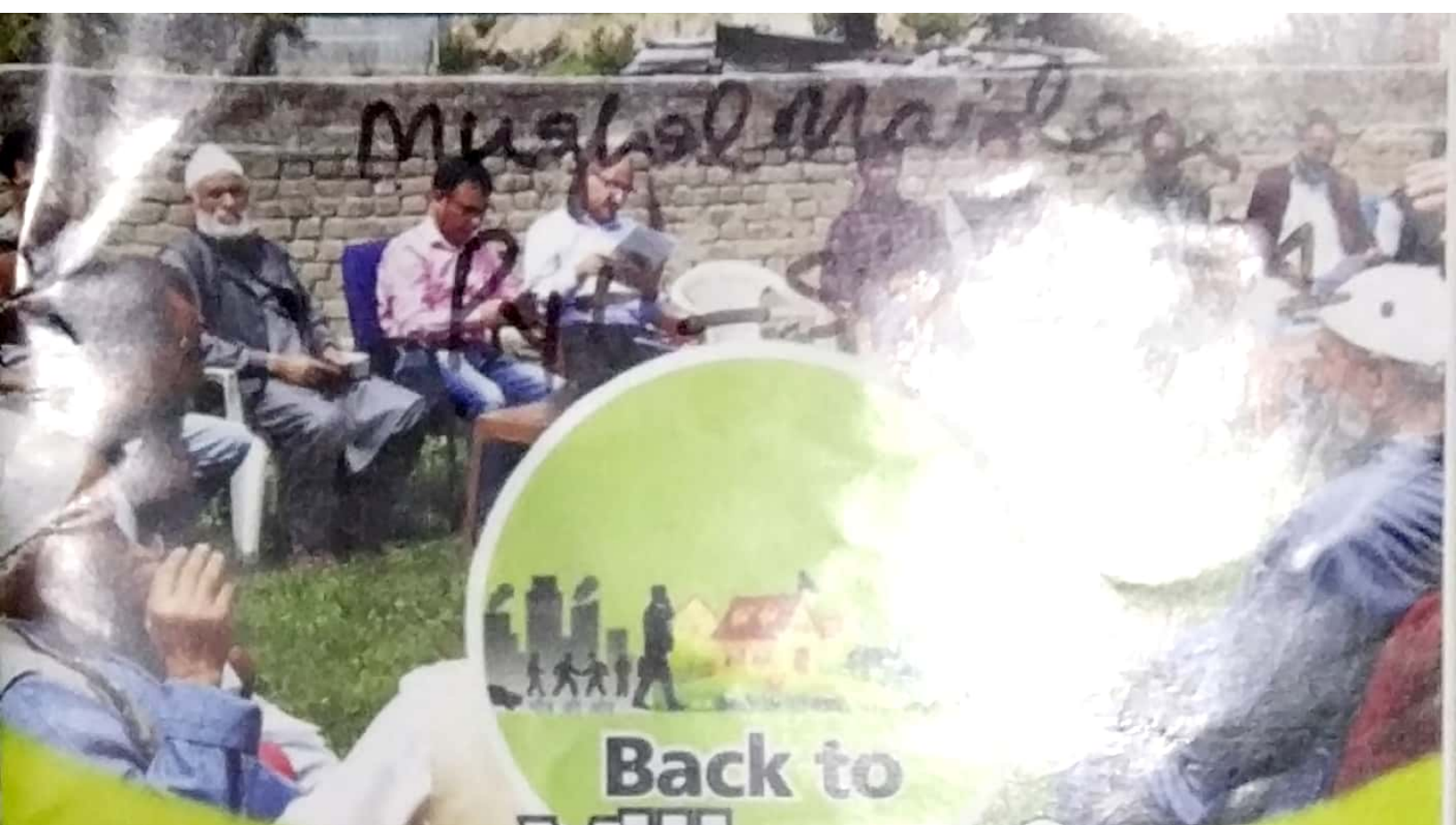

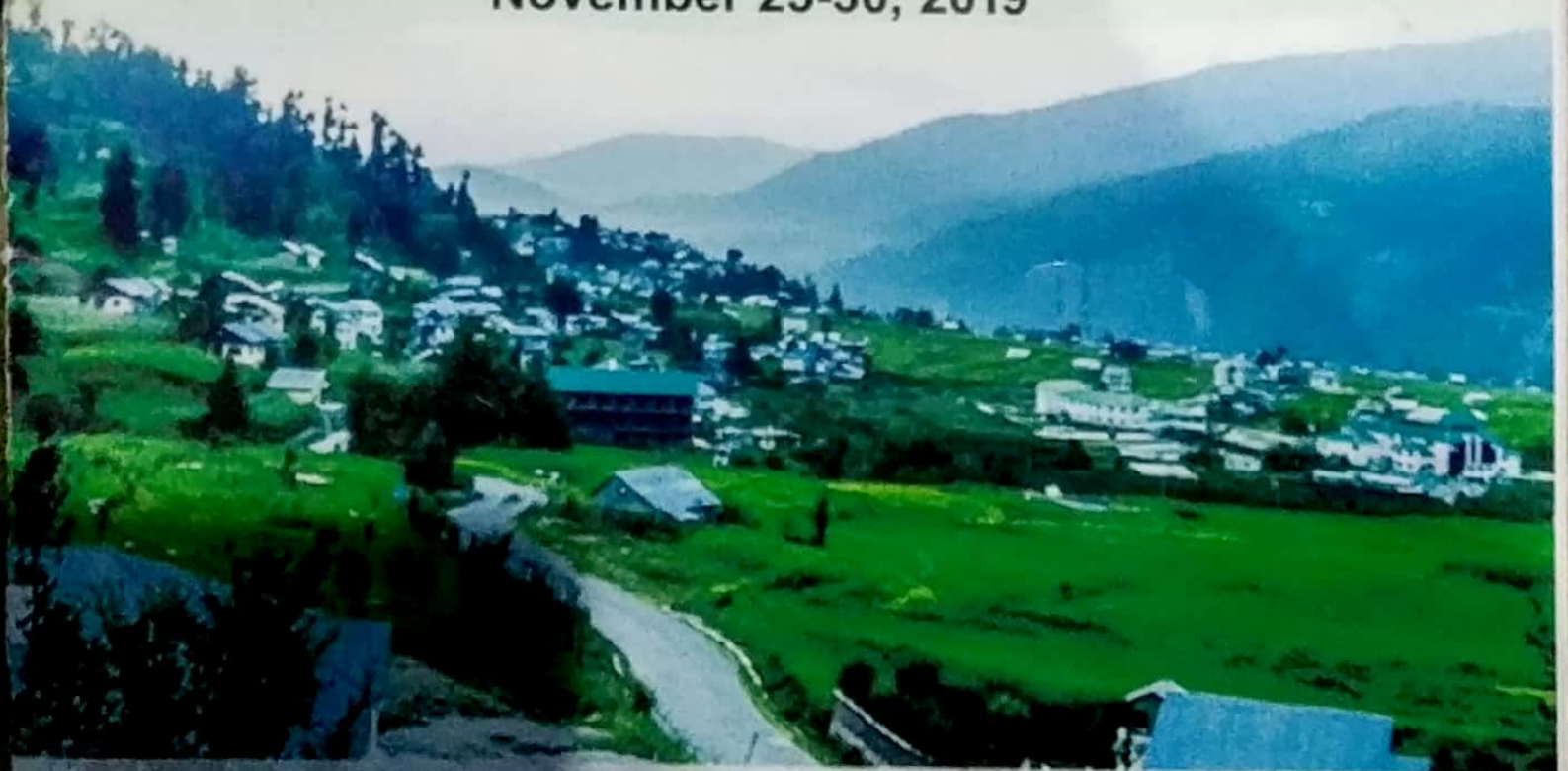

5.	Construction of School building near the Hindgam as the funds have already been sanctioned.
6.	Repairement of The Internal footpath in the Panchayat.
7.	Upgradation of High School Sigdi to Higher Secondary School.

	* Lack of tapped drinking water to the habitation mentioned in. * Lack of classroom for Middle School Hindgam functioning in a private building.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	The people have high expectations from govt. especially after a shift from statehood to UT. The masses are optimistic viz a viz new schemes being implemented in the UT.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The visit to the Panchayat allotted to Undersigned was satisfactory, though faced some difficult queries from the general masses about slow pace of development. As the B2V2 was conducted in less than 6 months of Back to Village 1st which saw a transition from statehood to UT & subsequent preventive restriction in the district so the work execution rate slow down which created a sense of despair among masses. But during the visit the people seemed optimistic as the government departments have started functioning in a more vibrant mode. The only suggestion to make Back to Village phase 2nd a successful is that atleast one work/project taken up after the visit needs to be completed before conducting a second visit so that the confidence of the people is restored.
