III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Satisfactory upto some extent for me, but not as per the public views. Whatever Govt has done while launching this back to village i.e. B2V2 after the completion of 1st phase, imbibed its feedback from the ground, doing homework & implementing practically in some instances throughout the state/UT in such a short period of time under all sorts of difficulties is commendable. But a small no. of people who are not well versed with the ground realities & due to lack of awareness feels other wise, as they want to expect everything to be on the ground before the start of B2V2 which is extremely difficult.

As per my assessment, people do not show as much enthusiasm & energy as they did during B2V1, because they were expecting a lot on the ground before start of B2V2 as they pinned high hopes after B2V1. But I am very much confident that the people will definitely feel better when these schemes will be implemented on the ground in a minimum period of time to get the desired results.

Ensure, the funds for all concerned schemes be released in time without any delay.

Ensure fixed time frame for completion of each project/scheme.
