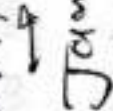

III Overall perception of functioning of the government: During my visit to Dindi Charakan Baidan from 25th March to 28th Feb evening, I came across among prominent people of Panchayat including Panchayat elected Sarpanch & other members of GP & observe that people are quite happy with the Govt. working especially like this Sarpanch. The local problems are solved at their own steps which was not possible during the previous elected Govt. regime. But at the same time they want more works to be taken up for execution which are highlighted in Back to Village Programme. They also say Govt. officials are working more honestly & efficiently than before.

IV Overall assessment of village and suggestions:

1) The overall assessment is that the living conditions of the village is not that good as the power & water supply is not good. During peak season of rice farming, which is their life line, there is always shortage of water & power supply because of these factors, the farmers suffer a lot. The Govt. should start more programmes like Back to Village to make the farmers aware of the other options other than farming like handicrafts, etc. repairing courses, poultry farming, dairy products & many more. This will definitely upgrade living standards of the villages.

2) Gram Panchayat has including Sarpanch Sh. Neelam Singh & Secret of the Gram Panchayat are quite popular among the locals. The couple of Mr. & Mrs. Ravi Baidan are quite cooperative & helpful to the people of the Gram of Gram Panch. is quite cooperative of the villagers & good & they try to resolve the problems of the villagers & good & Panchayat will progress more & more under the leadership of Gram Panchayat itself.
